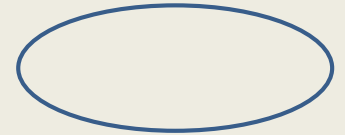

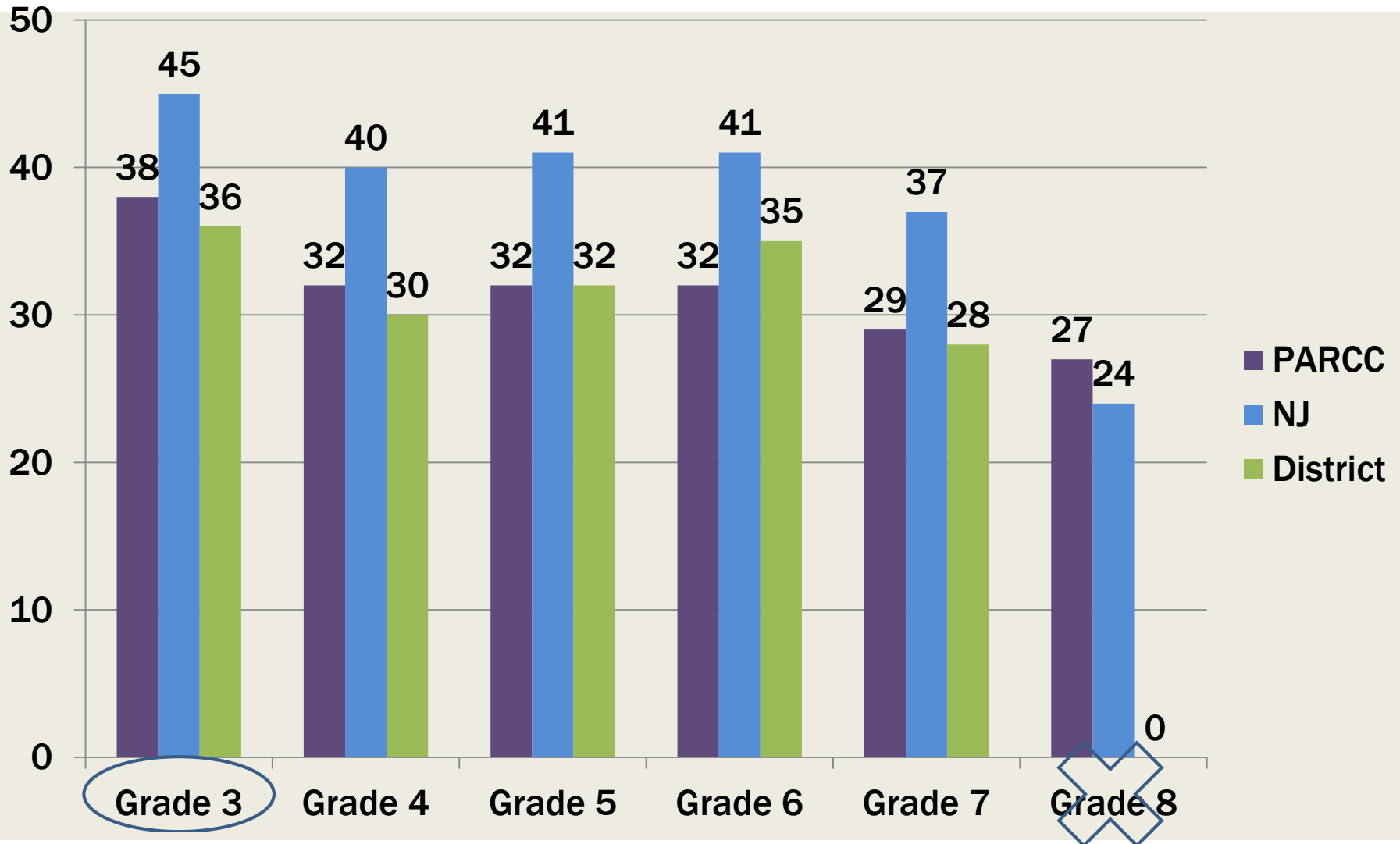

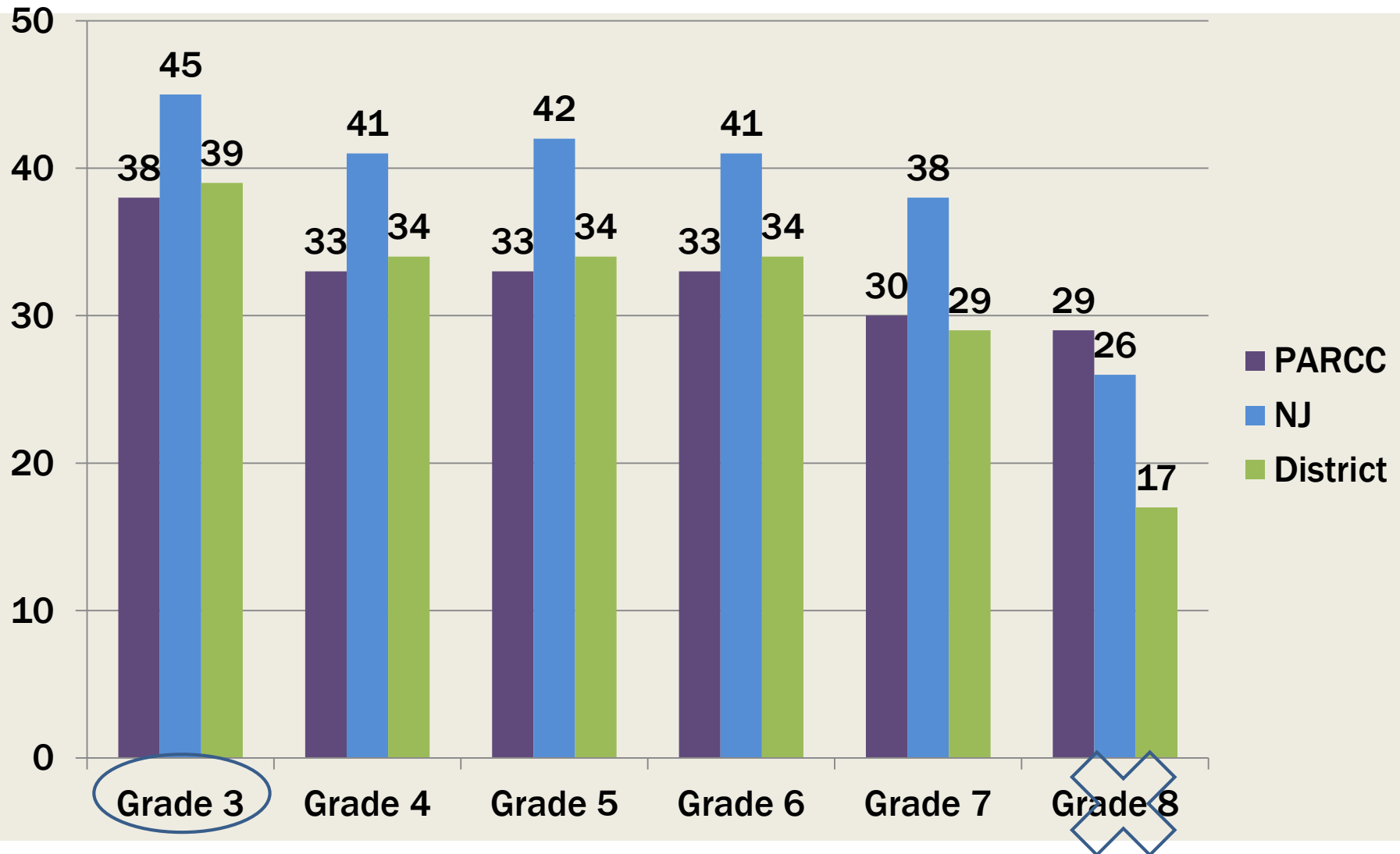
# PERCENT OF STUDENTS THAT MET OR EXCEEDED EXPECTATIONS MATHEMATICS GRADES 3 THROUGH 8



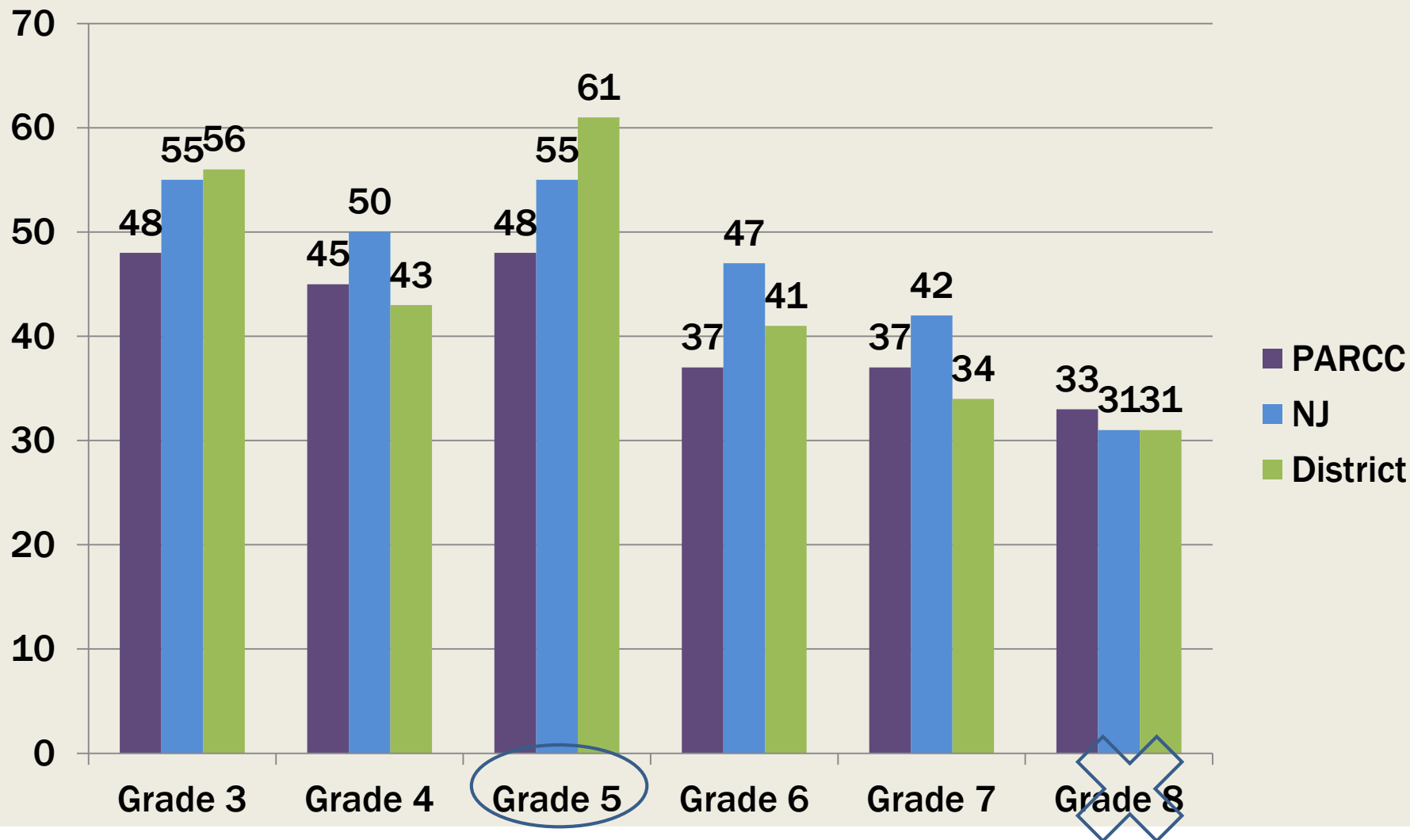

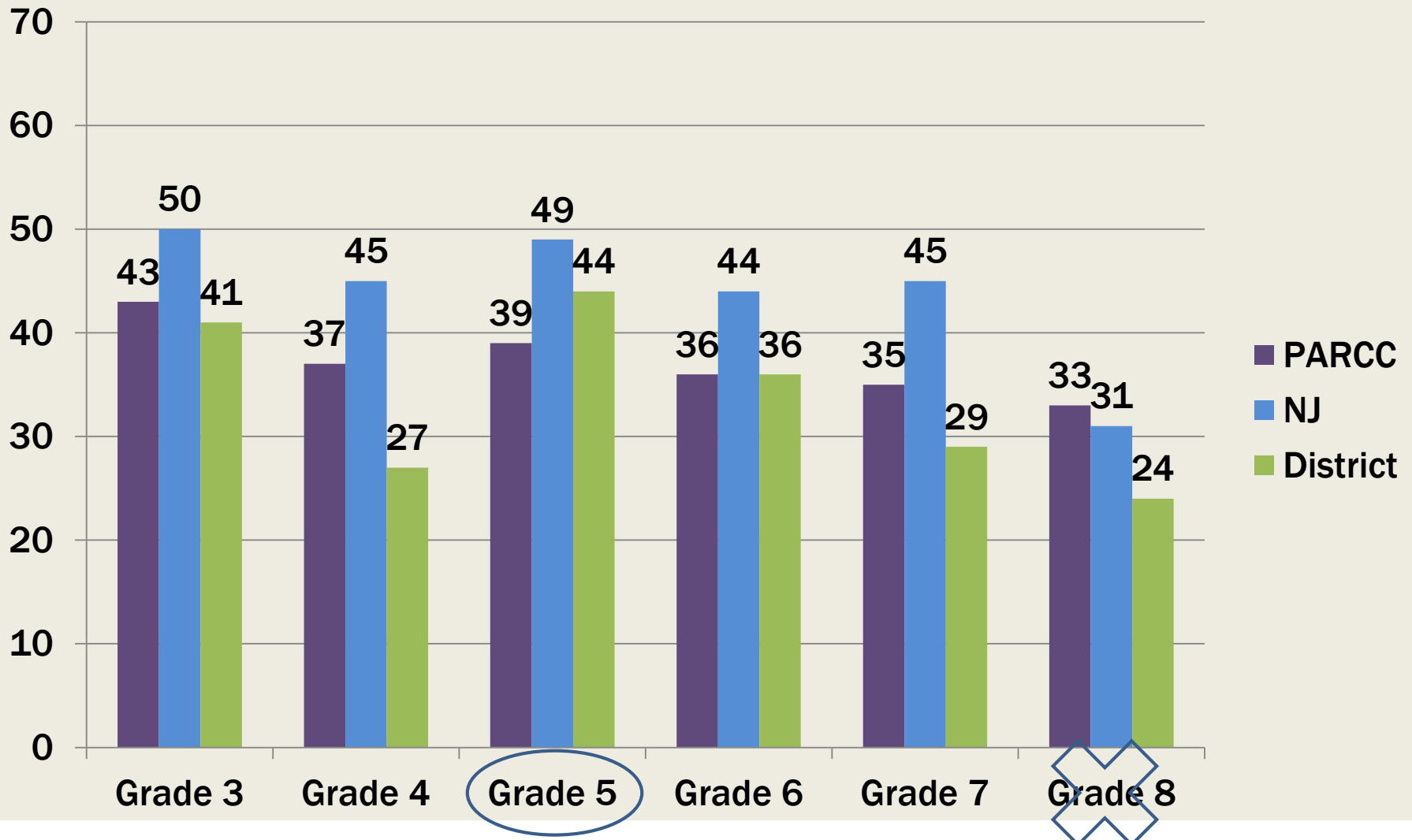

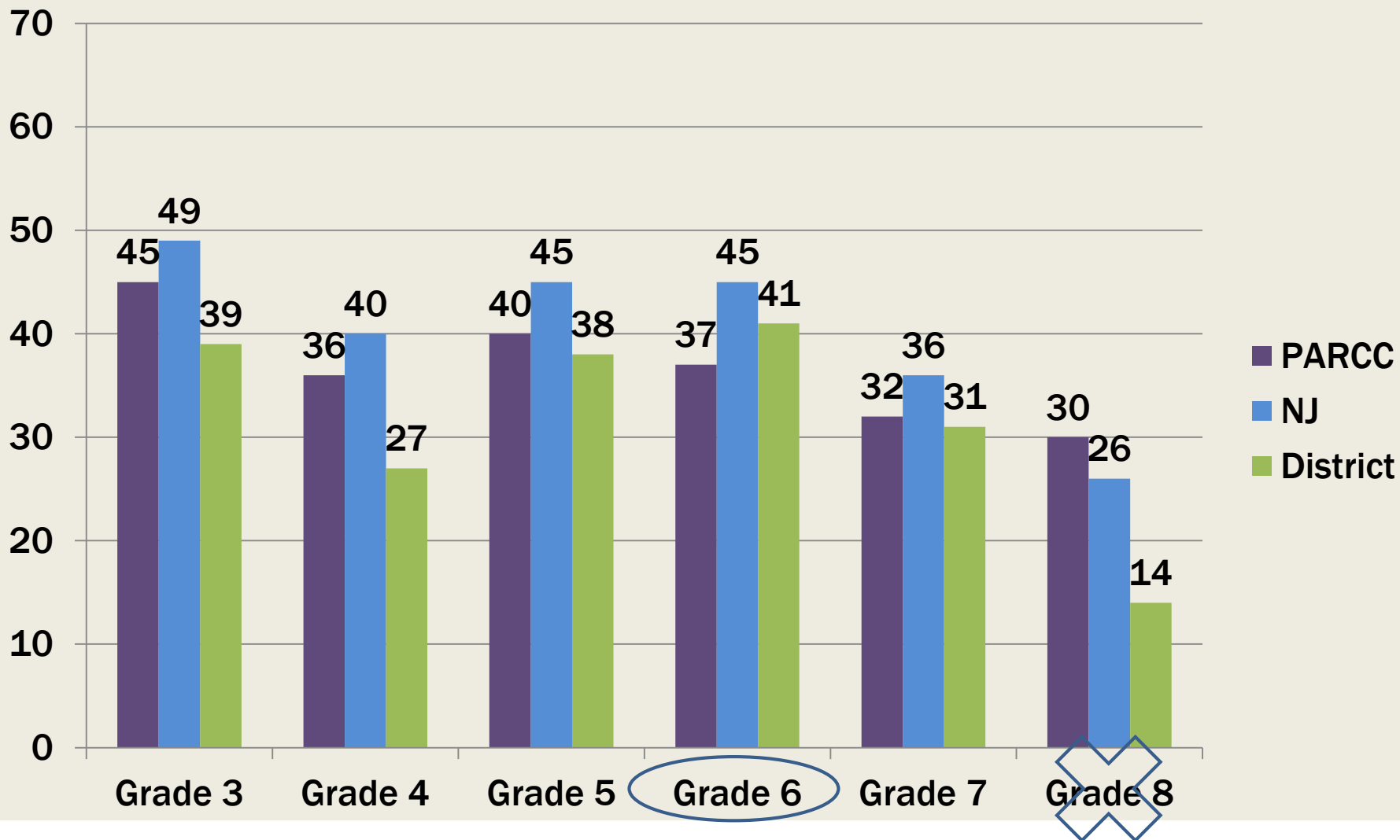

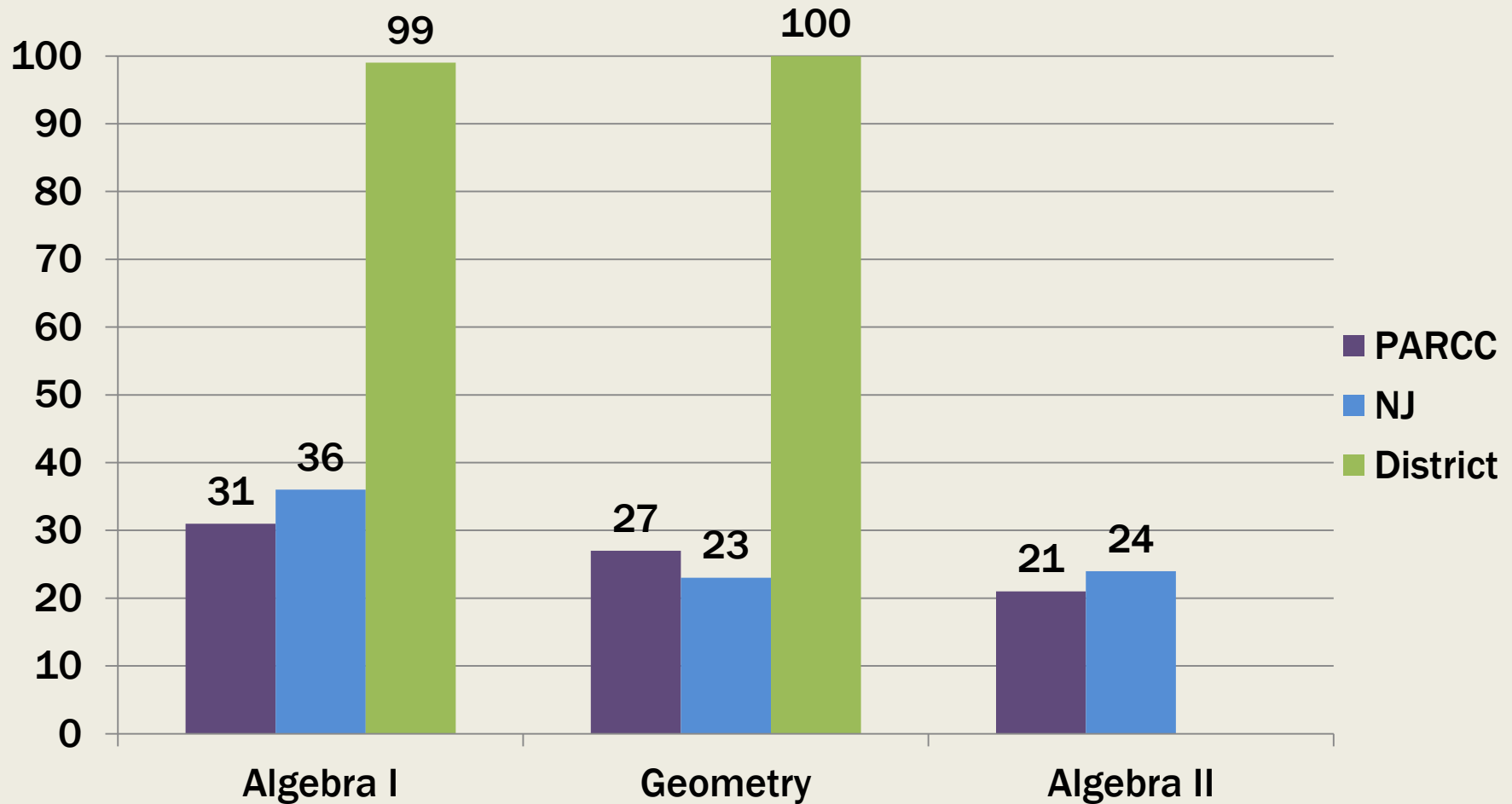

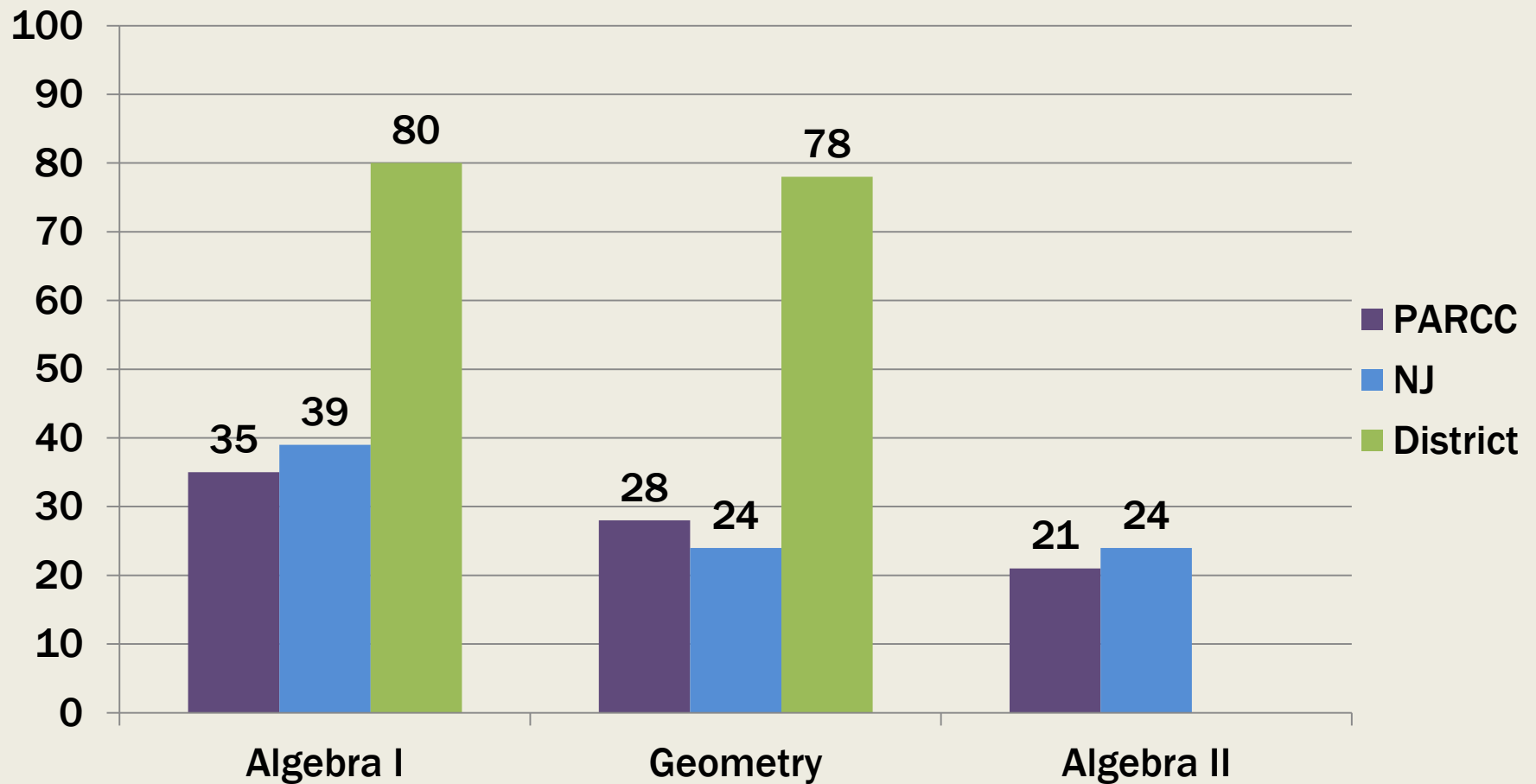


# PERCENT OF STUDENTS THAT MET OR EXCEEDED EXPECTATIONS END OF COURSE MATHEMATICS



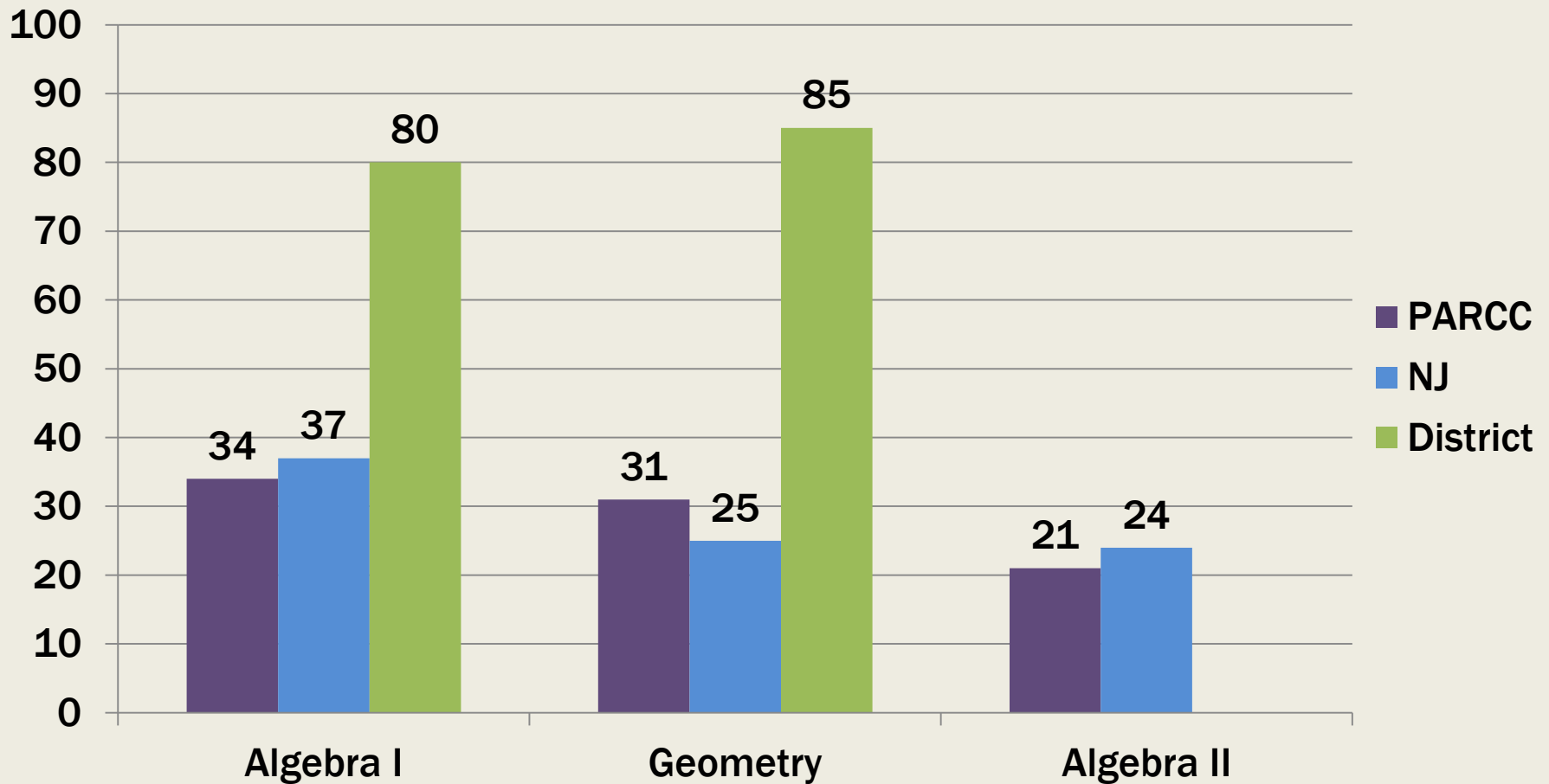
# PERCENT OF STUDENTS THAT MET OR EXCEEDED EXPECTATIONS

## END OF COURSE MATHEMATICS "MAJOR CONTENT"

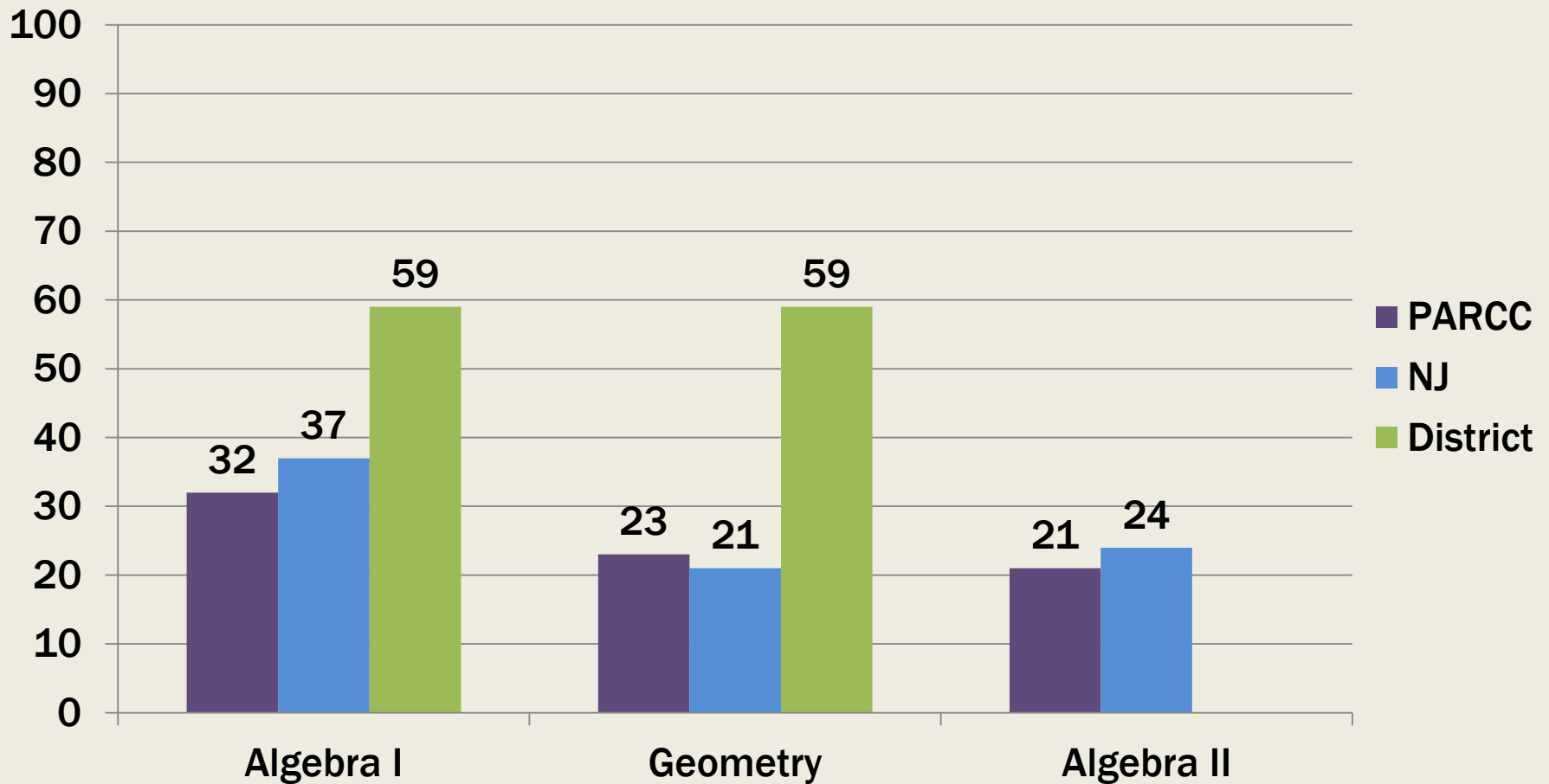

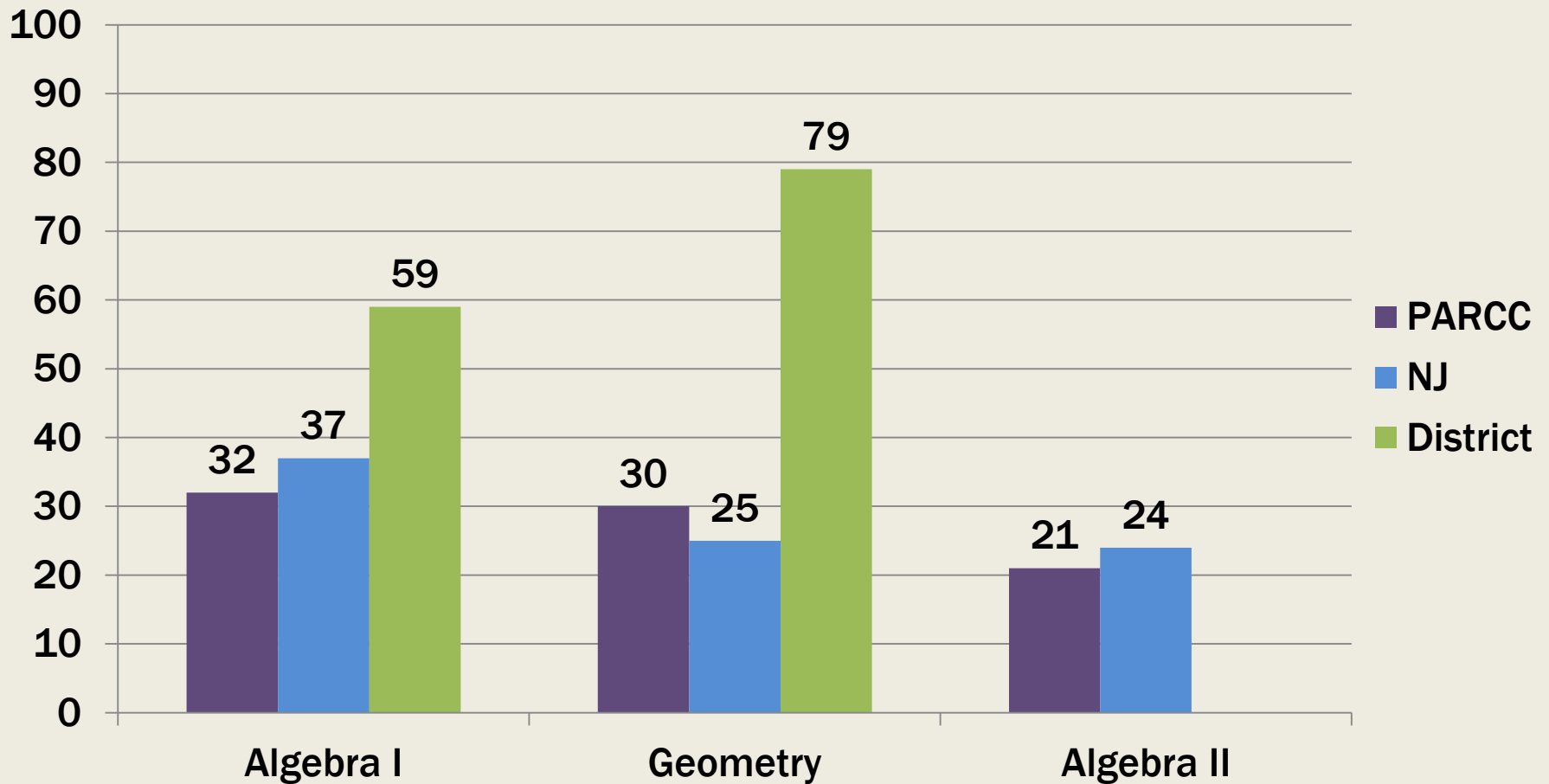
## END OF COURSE MATHEMATICS “SUPPORTING CONTENT”



# PERCENT OF STUDENTS THAT MET OR EXCEEDED EXPECTATIONS END OF COURSE MATHEMATICS “REASONING”

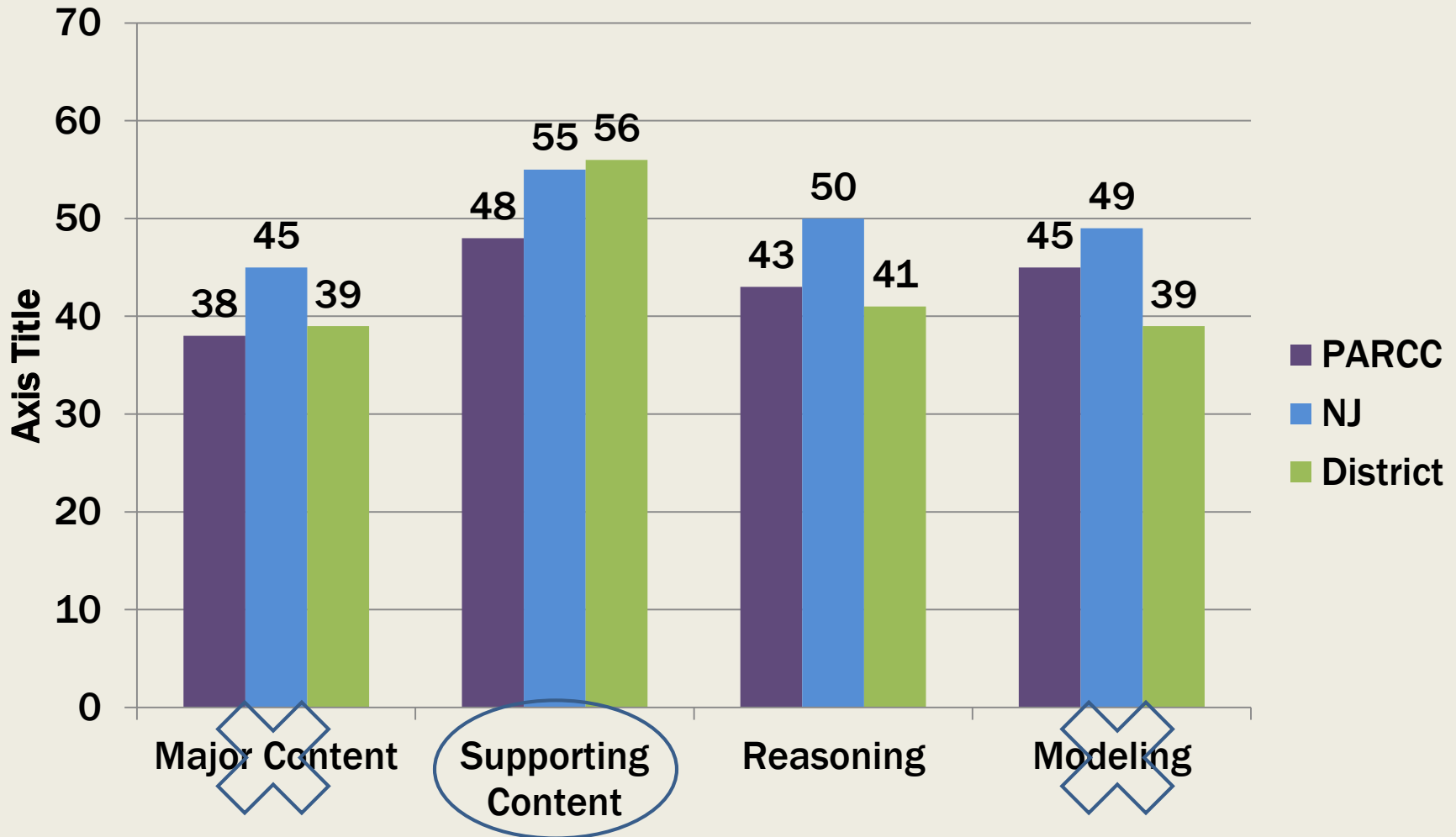


# PERCENT OF STUDENTS THAT MET OR EXCEEDED EXPECTATIONS END OF COURSE MATHEMATICS “MODELING”



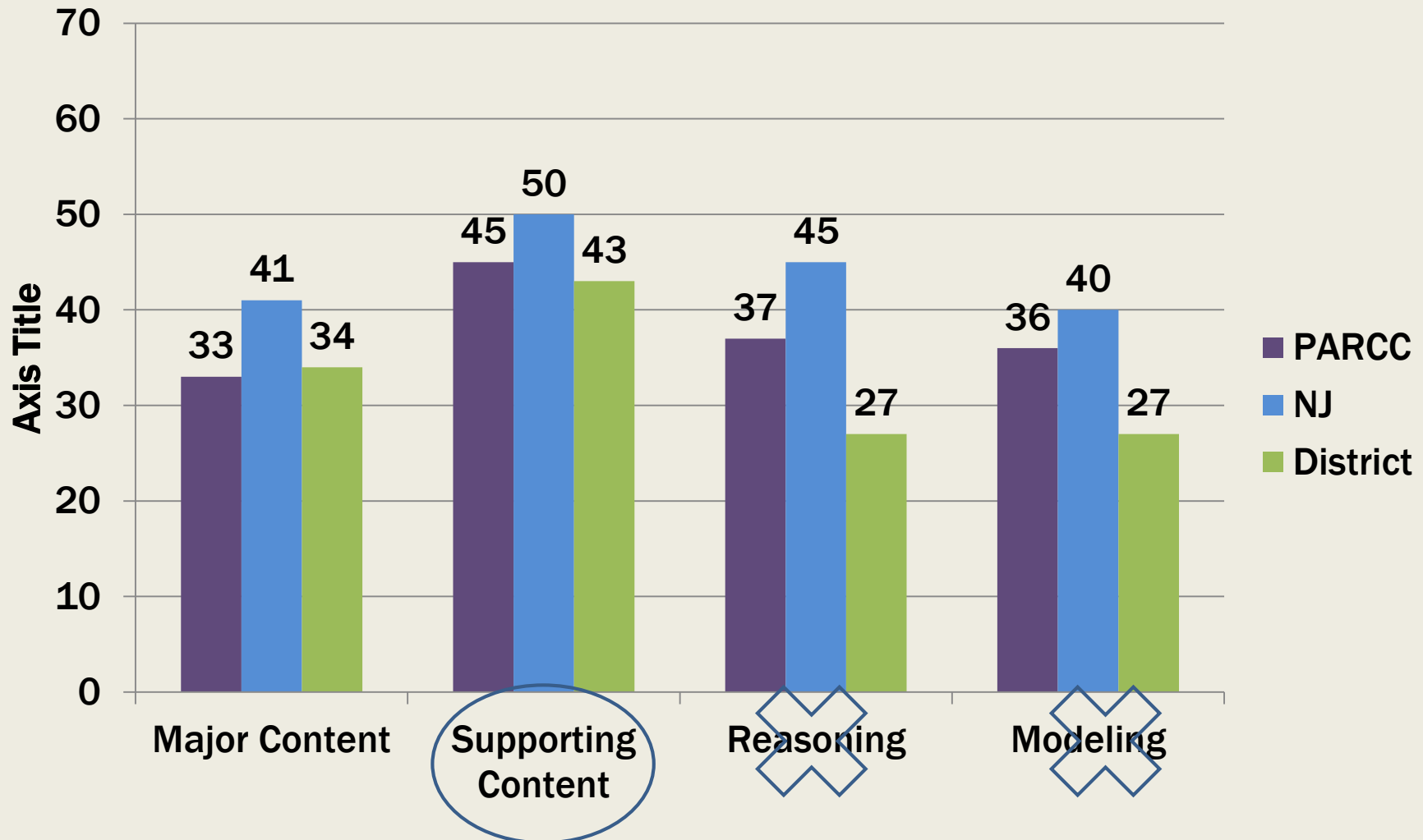

## MATH GRADE 3 "ALL SUBSETS"



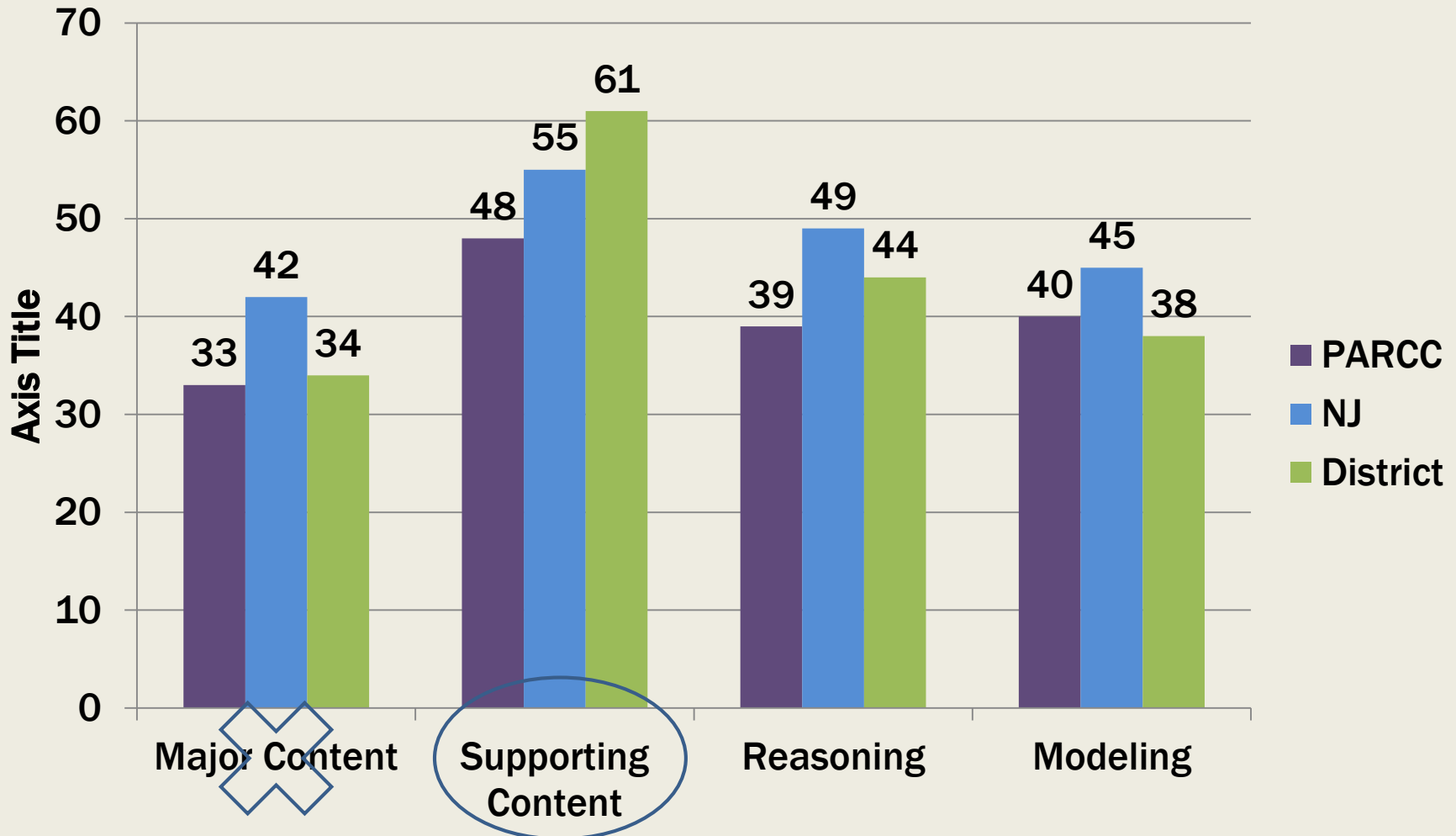

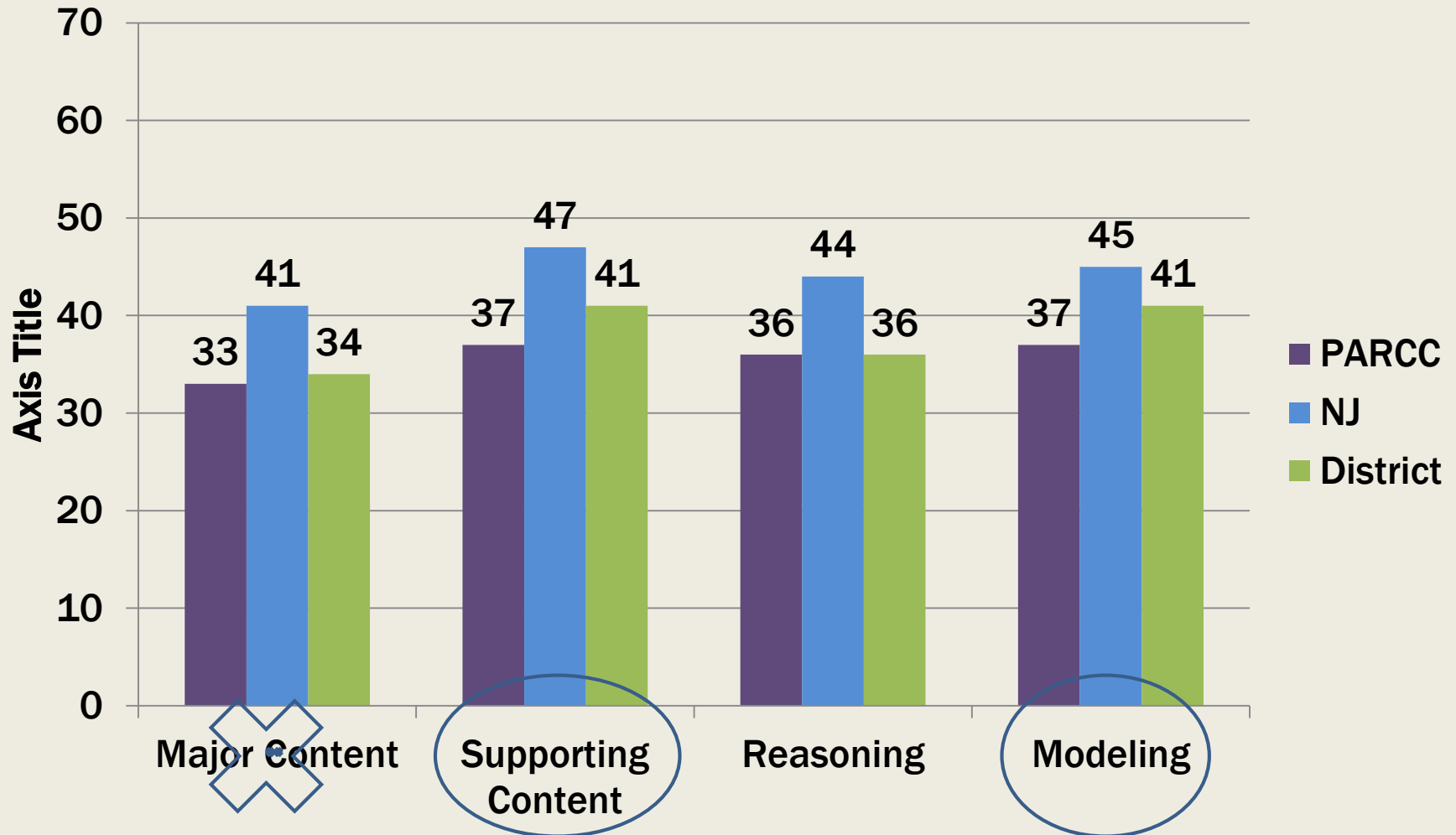

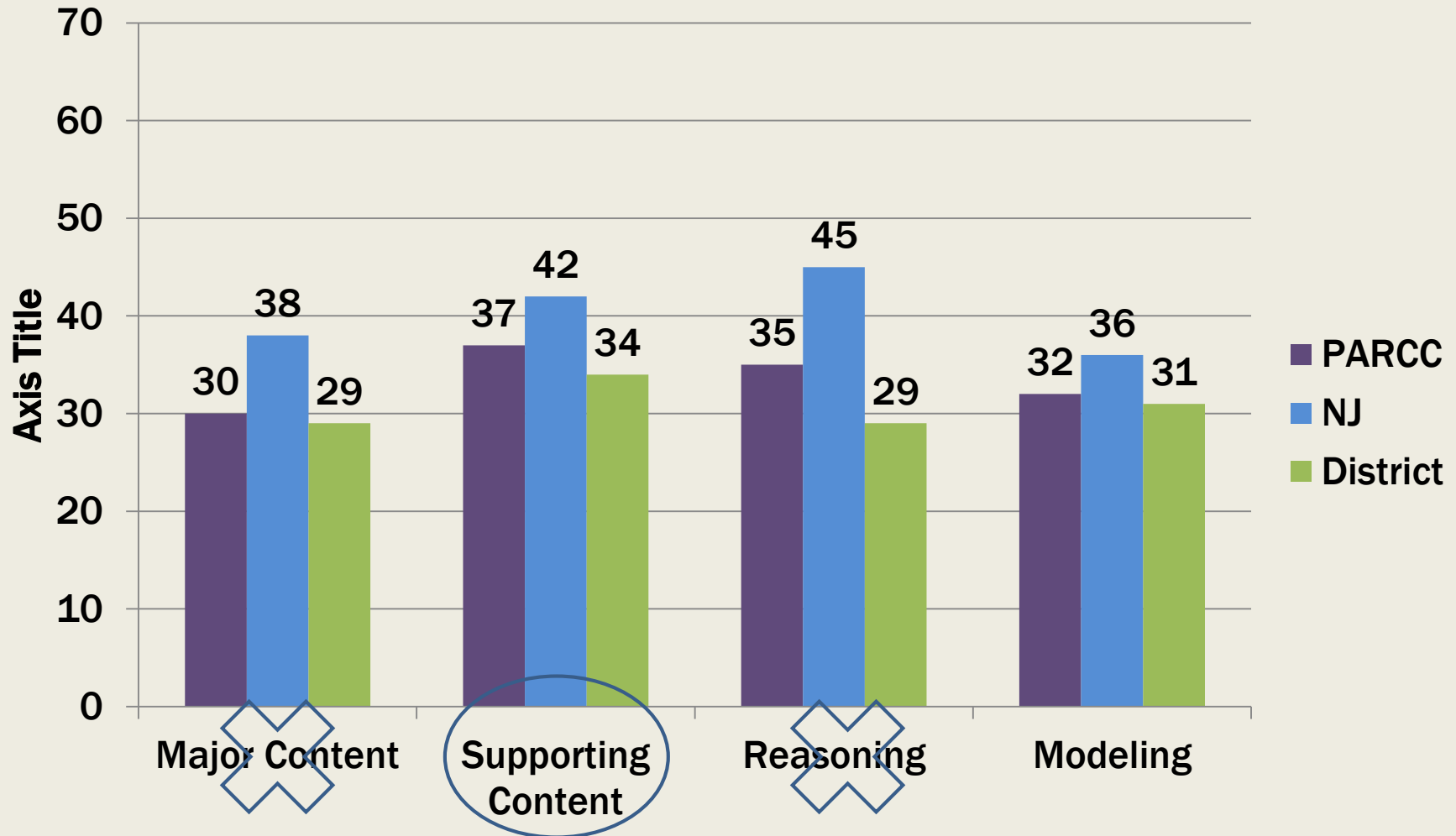

## MATH GRADE 6 "ALL SUBSETS"

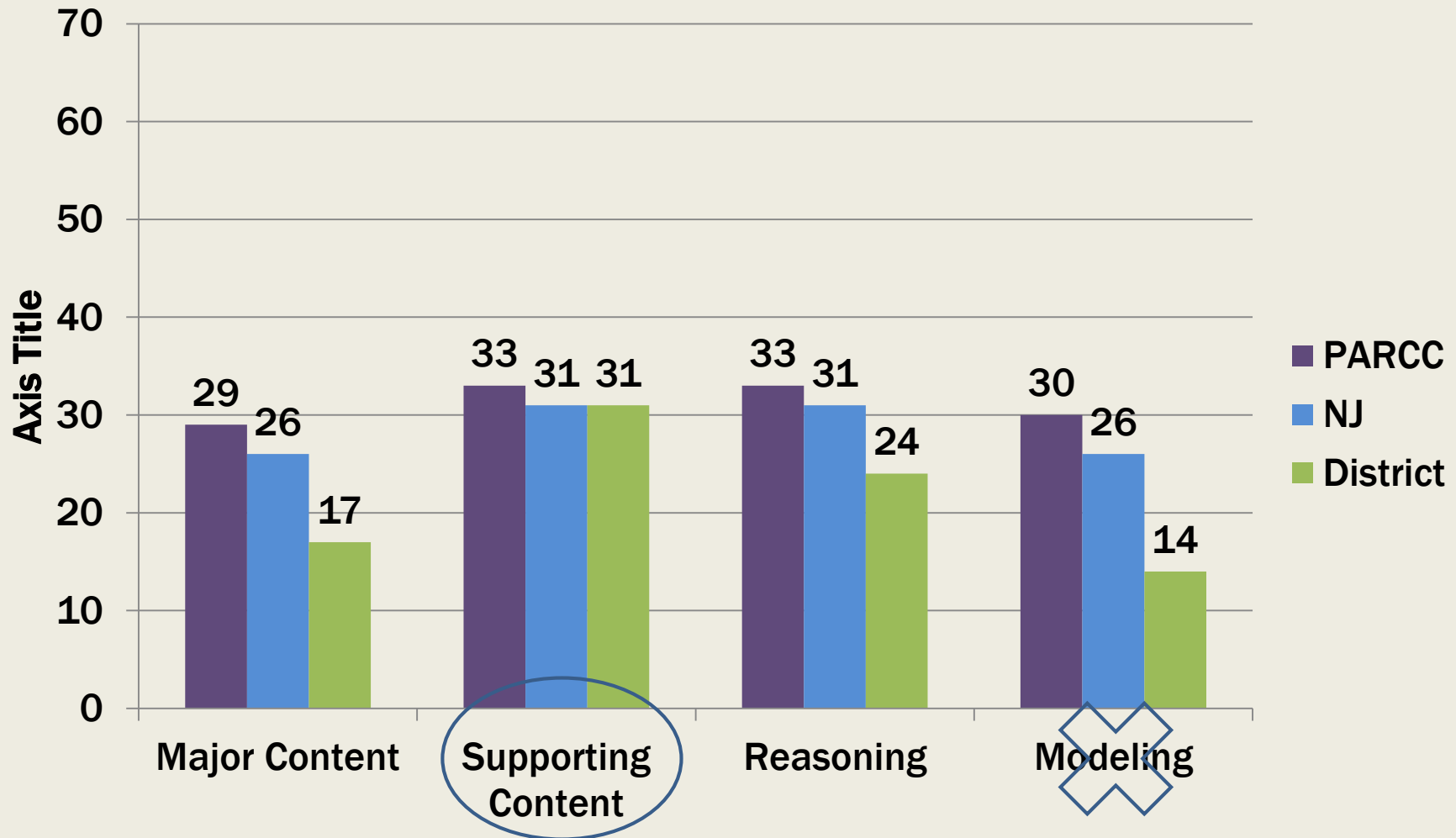

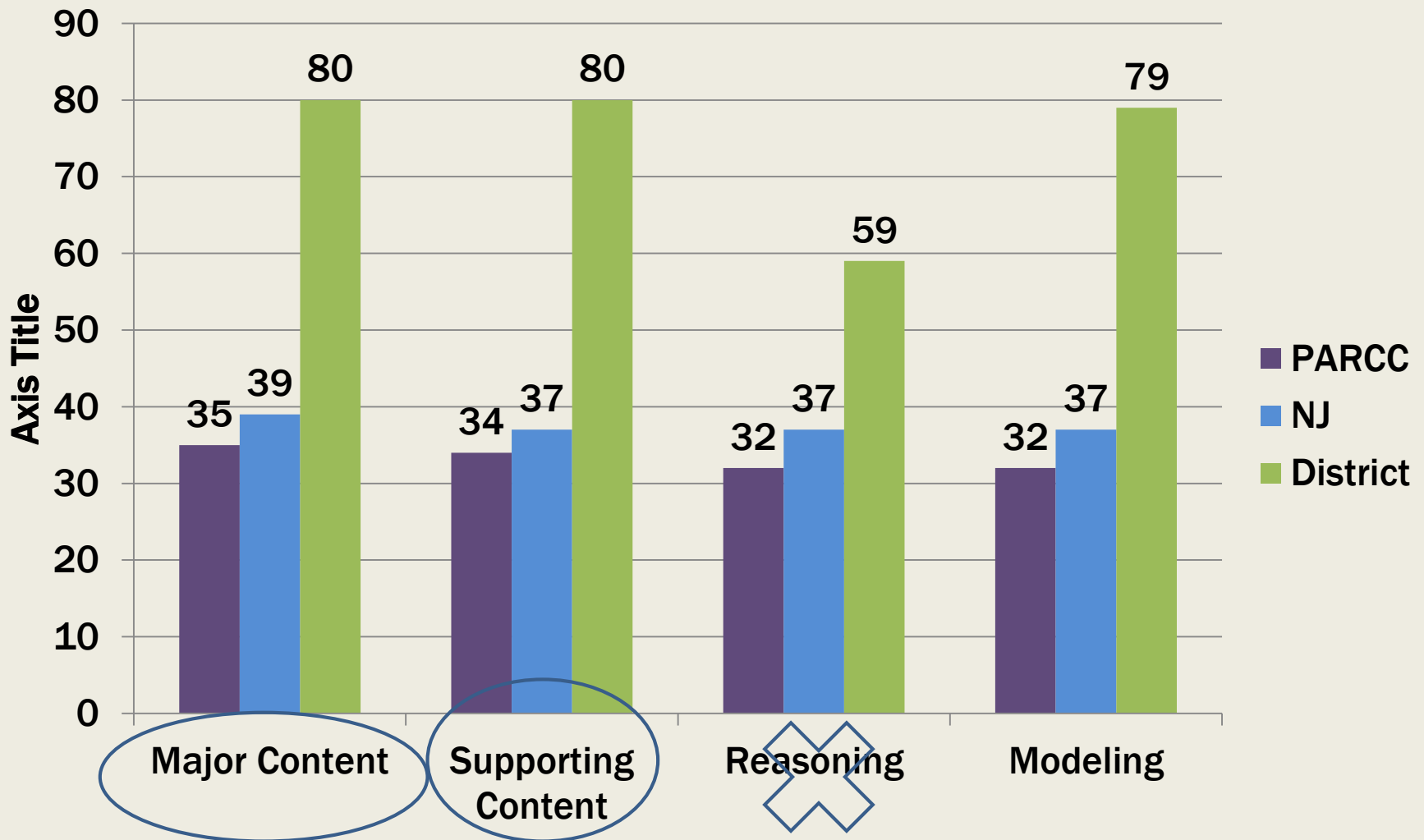


# PERCENT OF STUDENTS THAT MET OR EXCEEDED EXPECTATIONS MATH GRADE 8 "ALL SUBSETS"



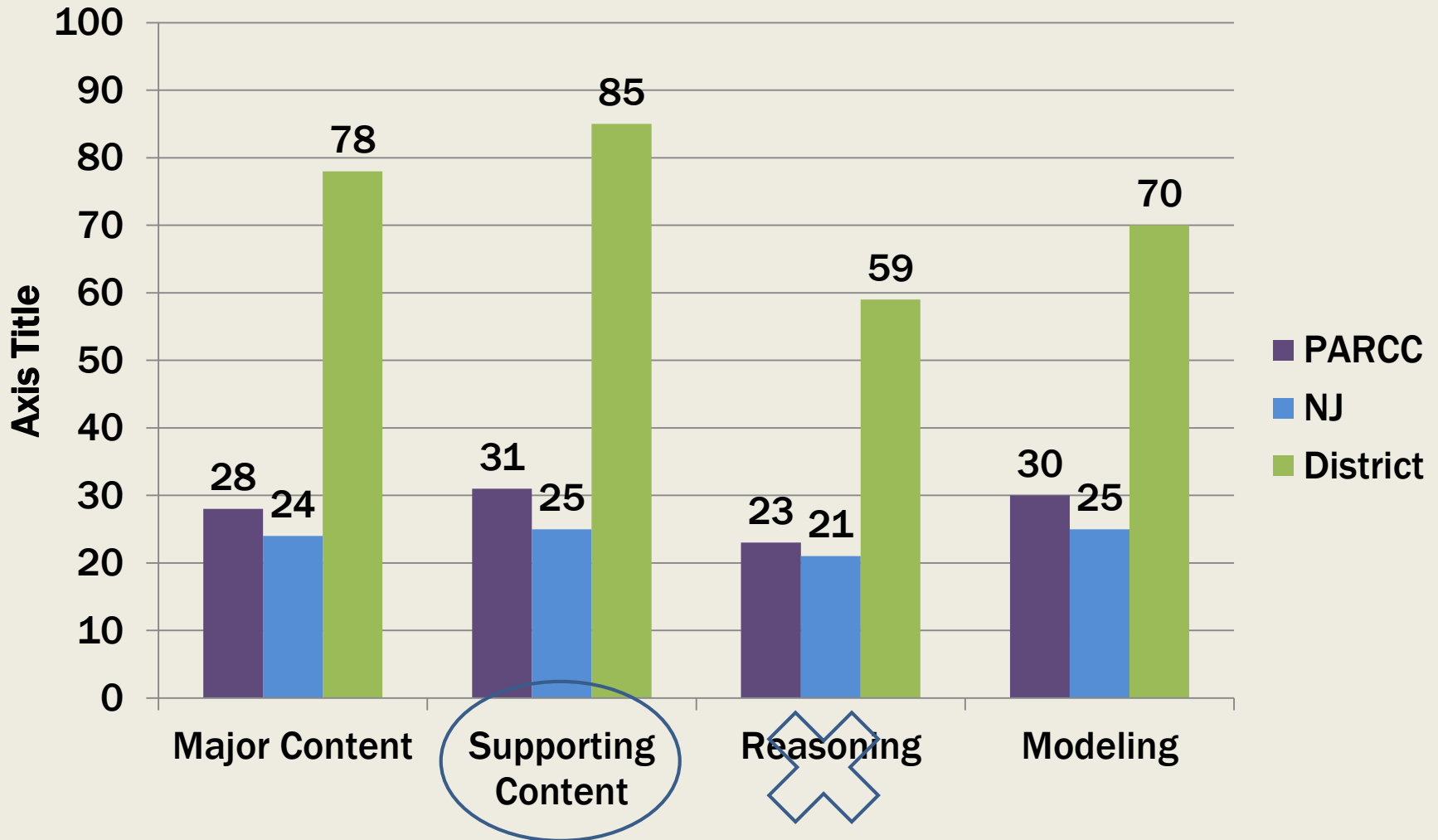

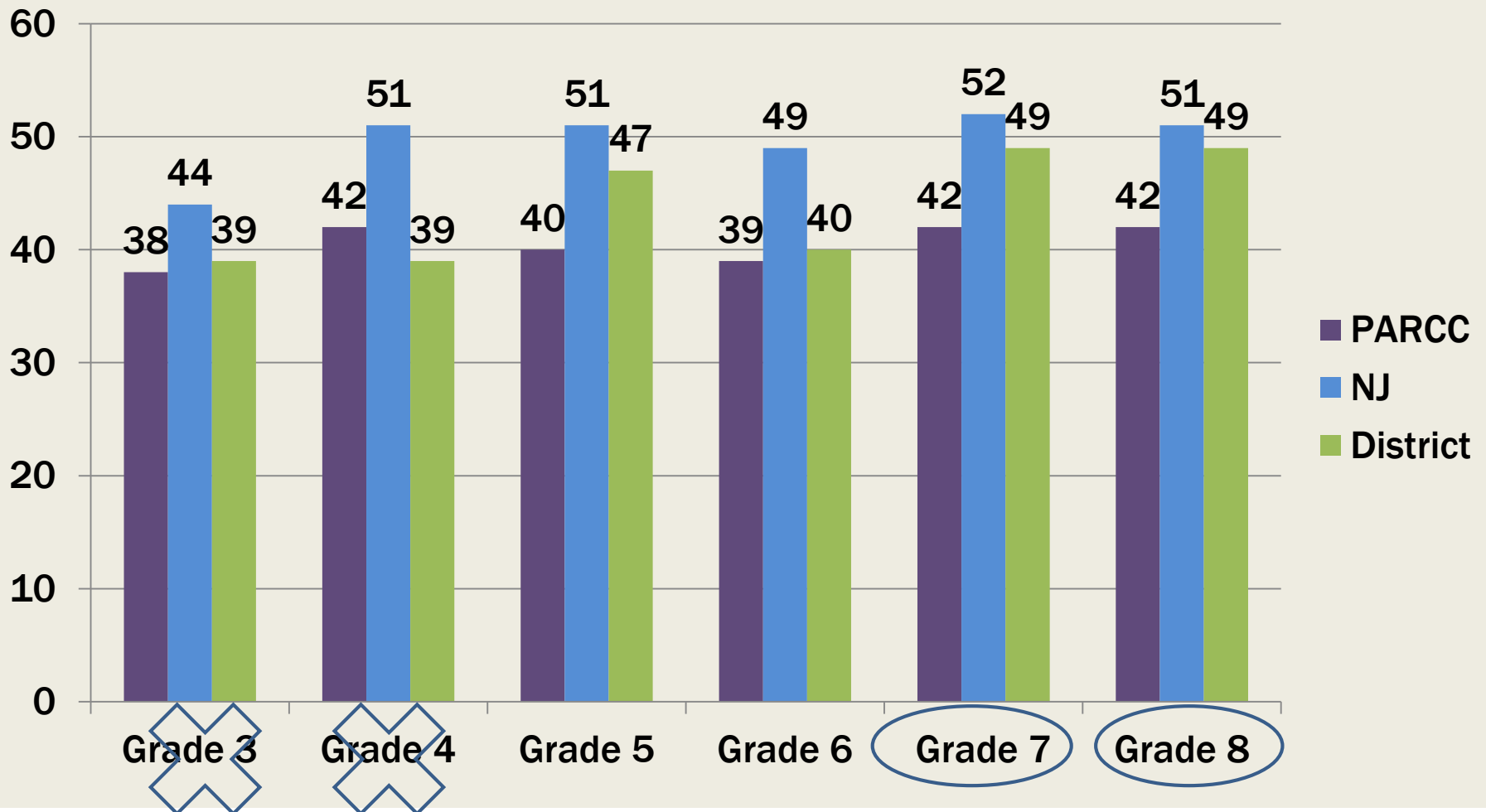

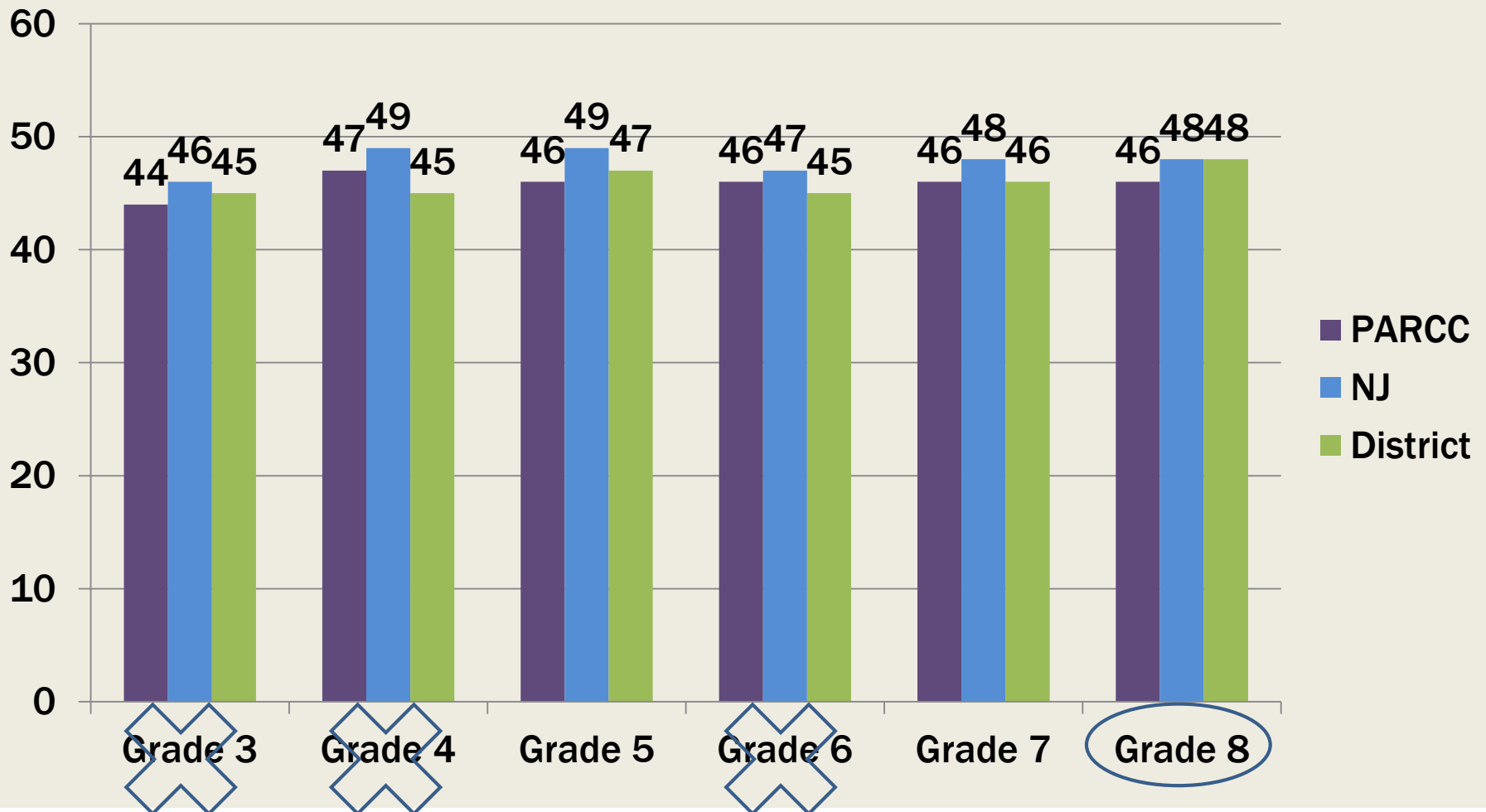

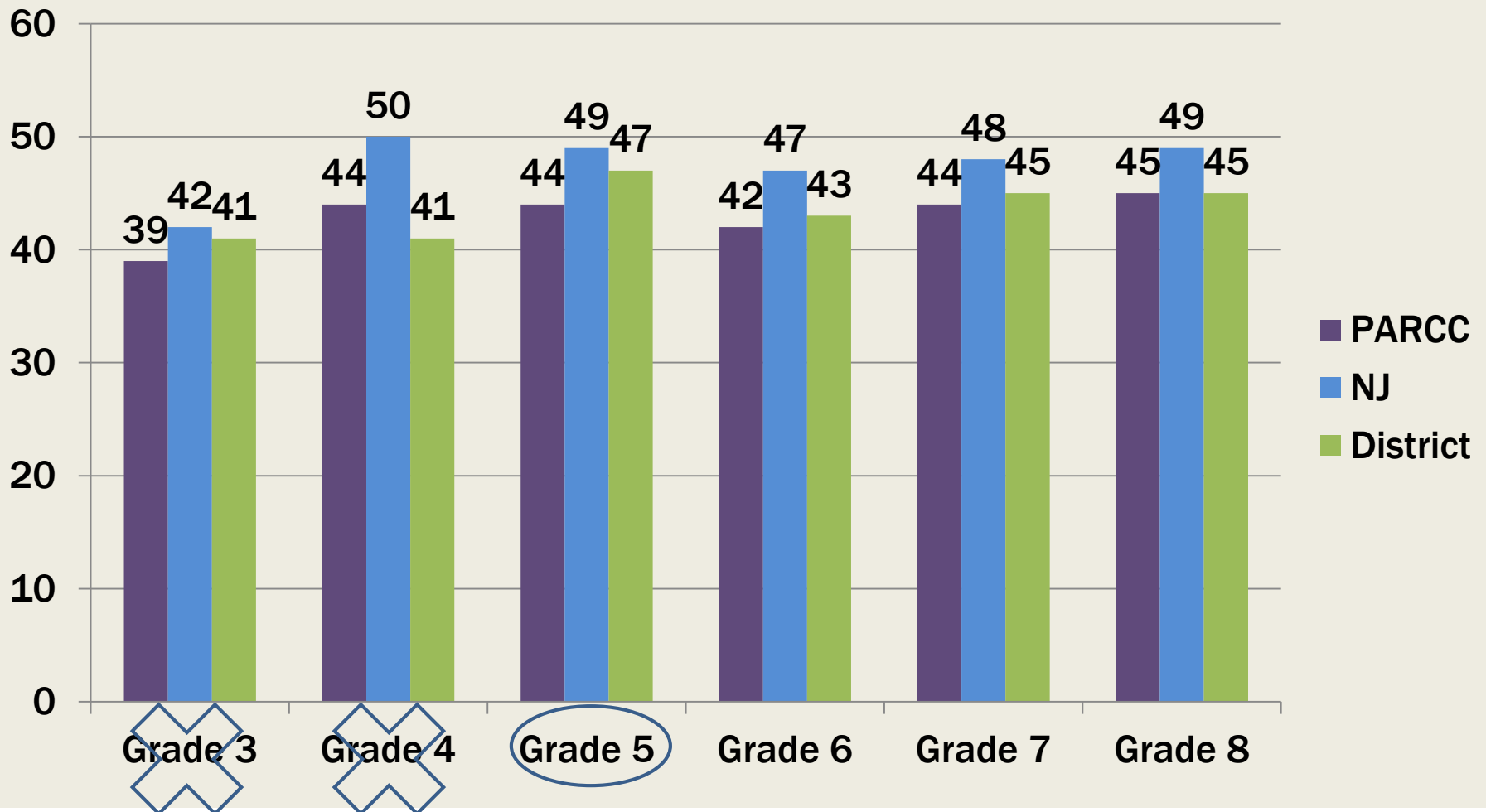

# AVERAGE SCORE READING ELA GRADES 3 THROUGH 8



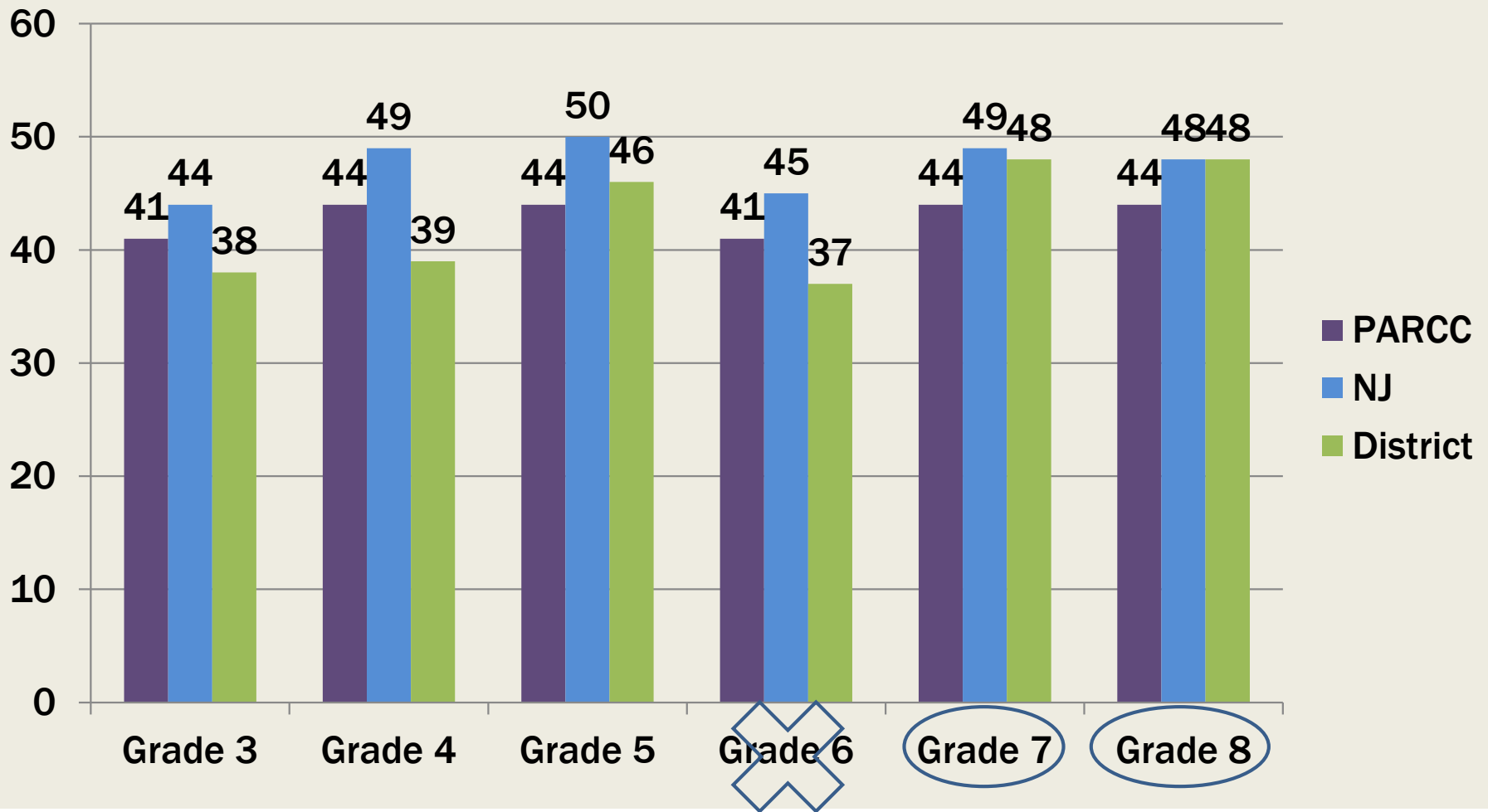

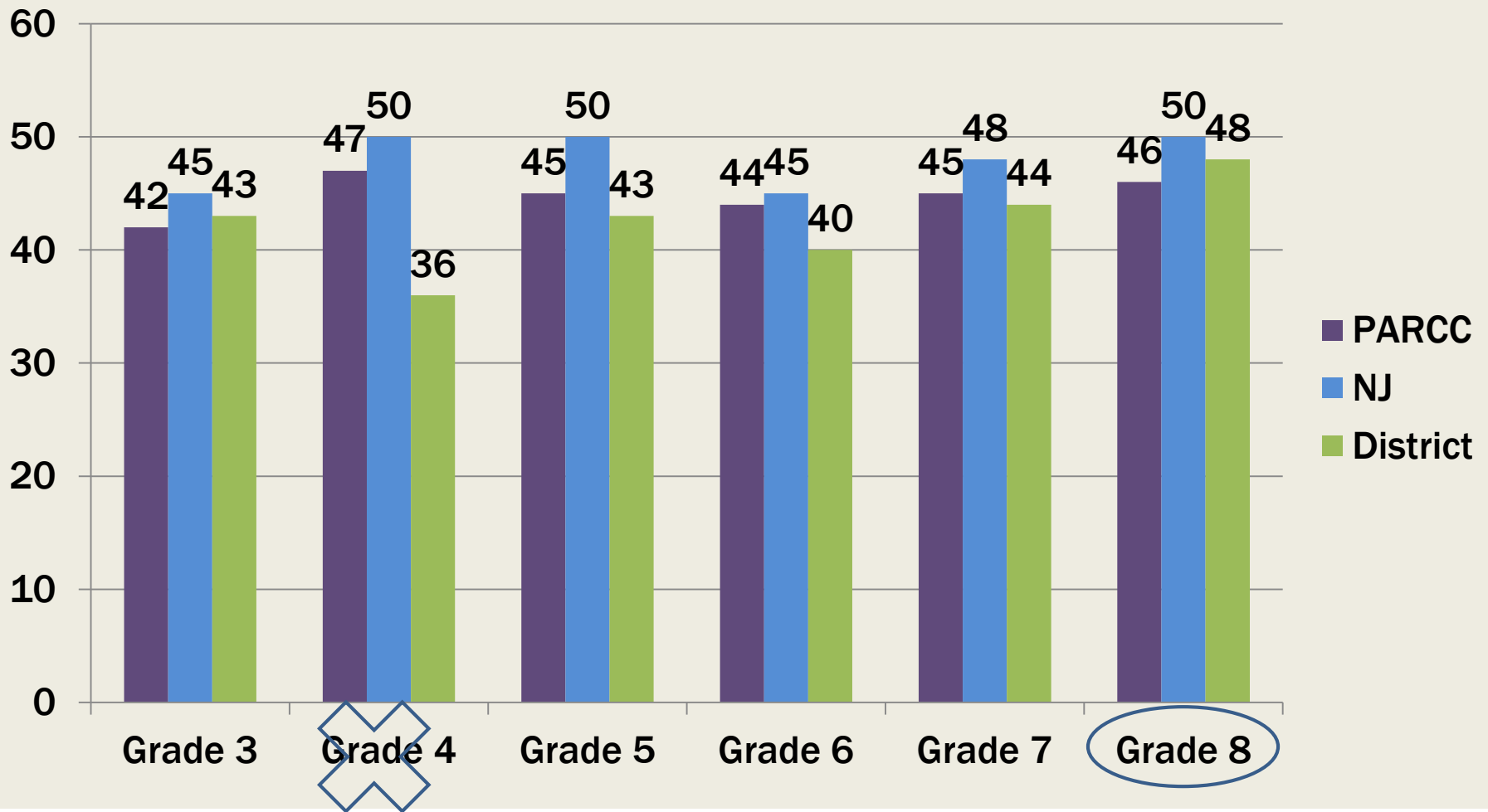

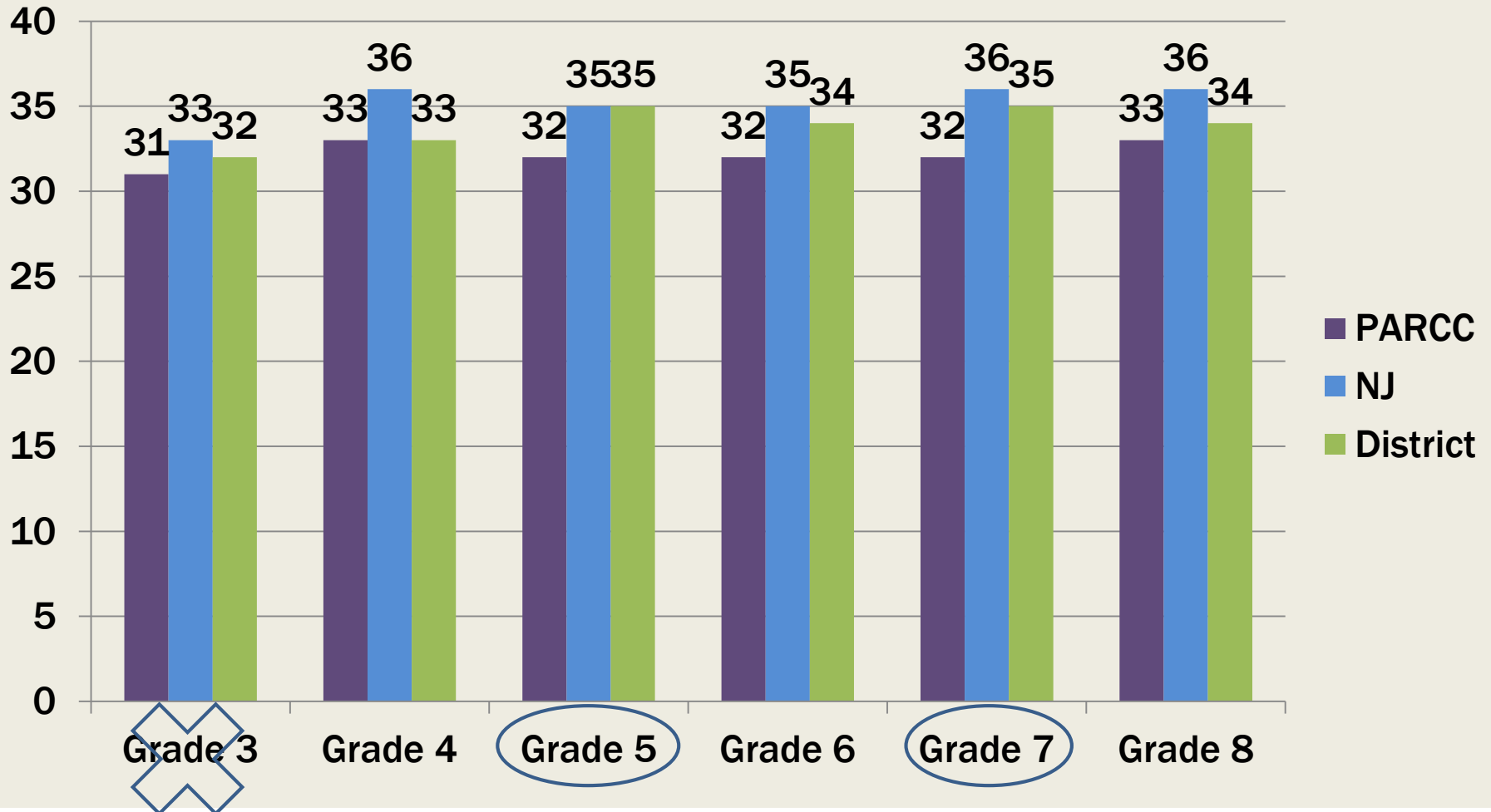
## ELA (READING) GRADES 3 THROUGH 8 **"INFORMATION"**



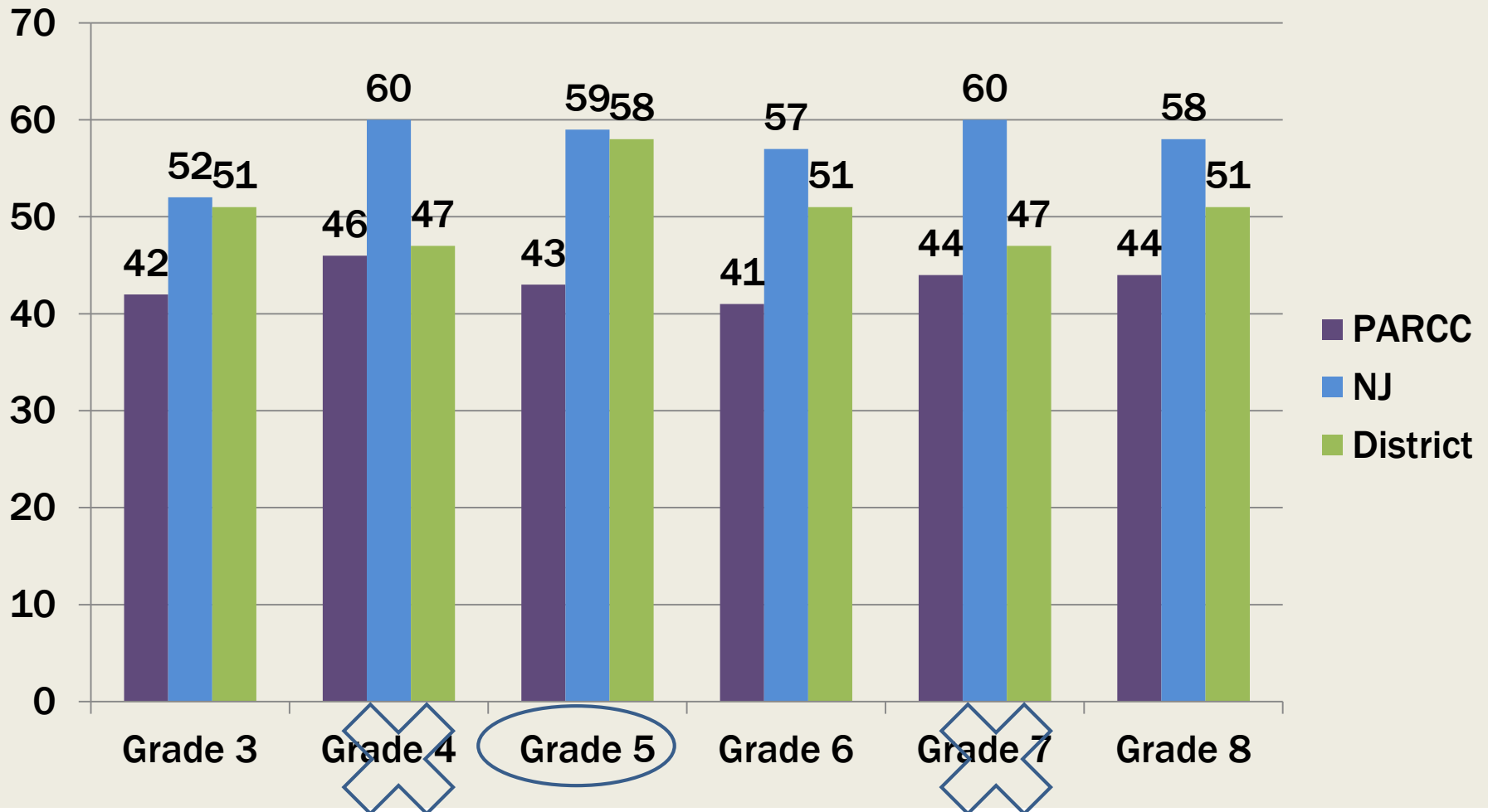

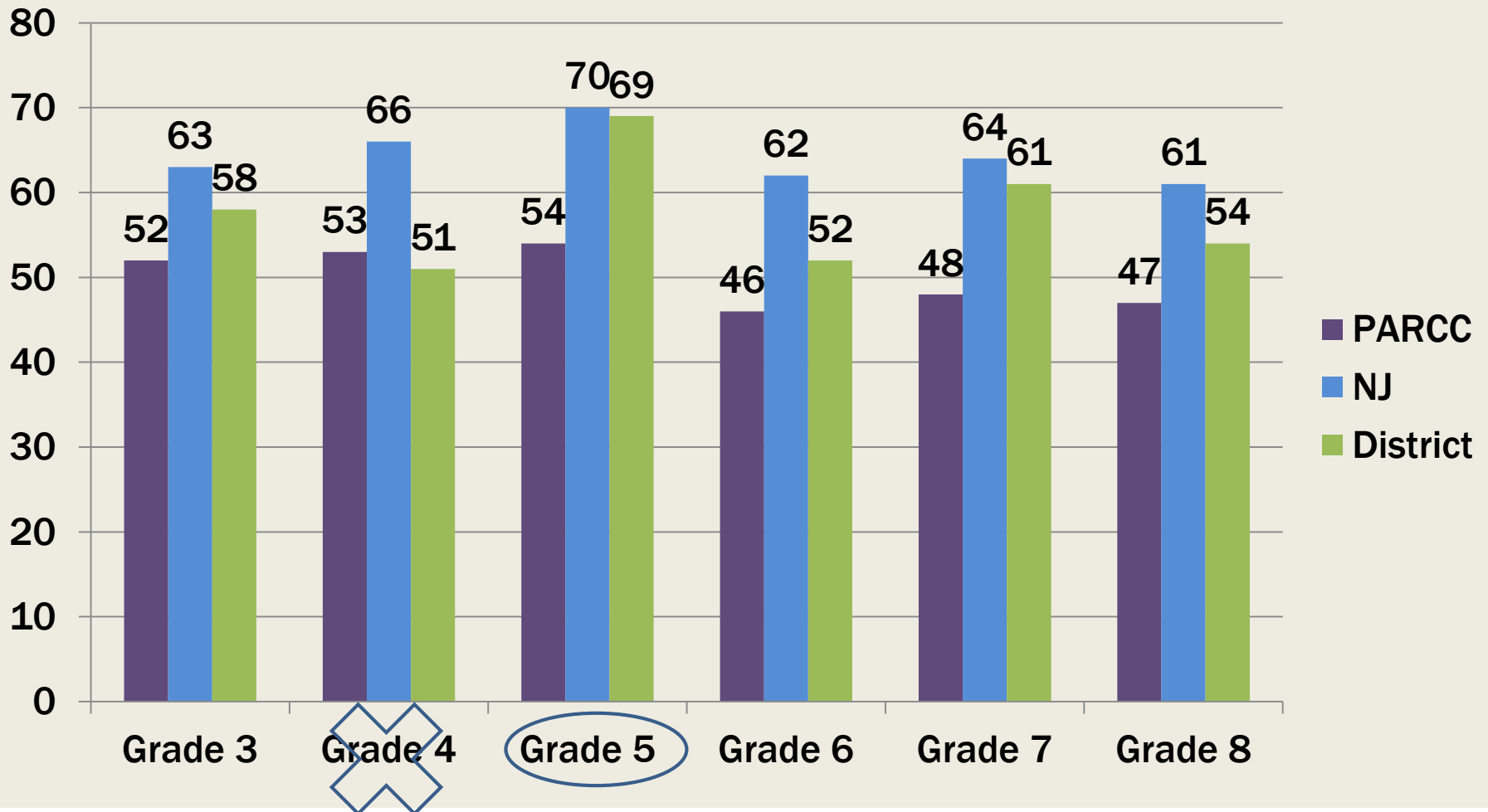
# AVERAGE SCORE WRITING ELA GRADES 3 THROUGH 8

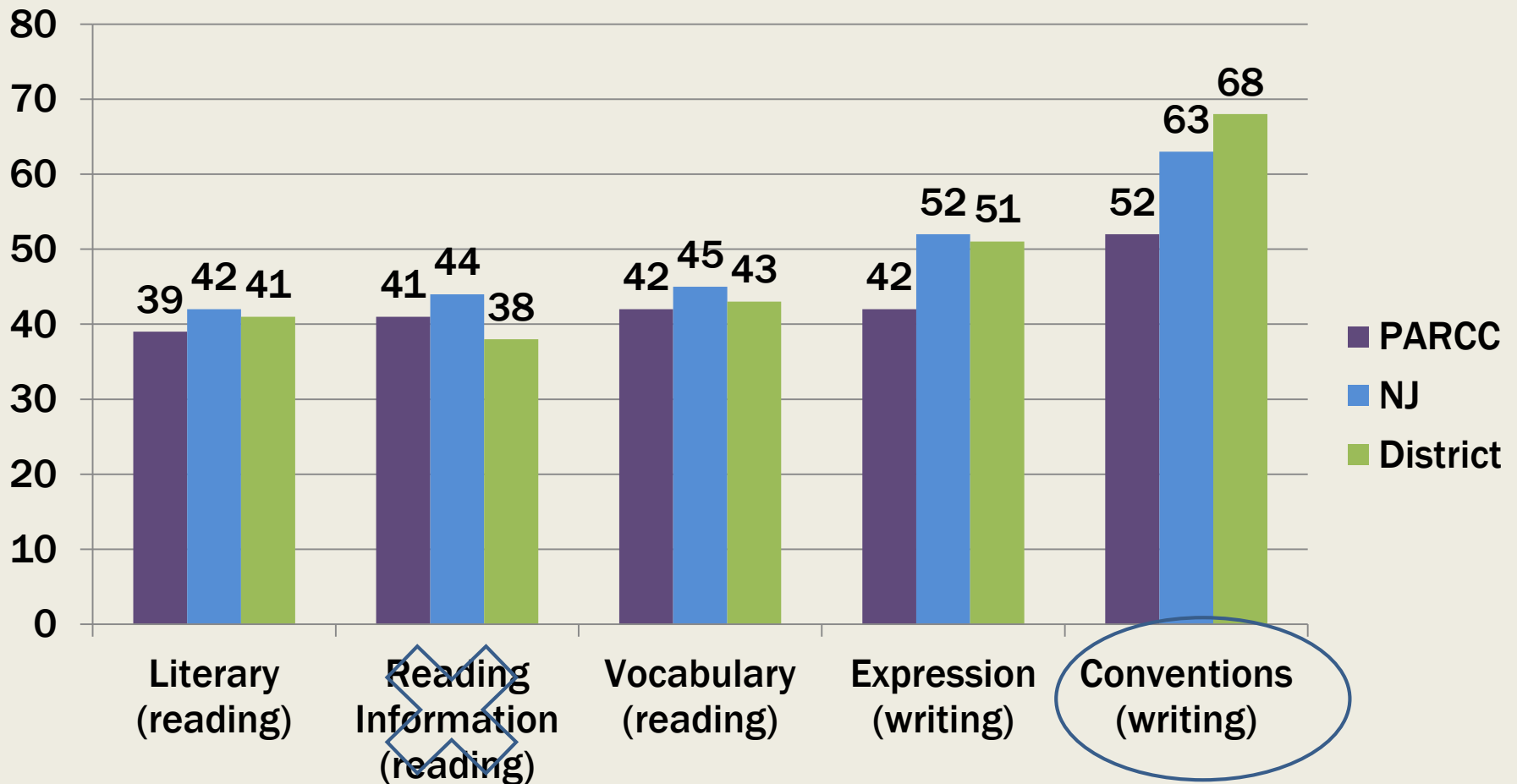

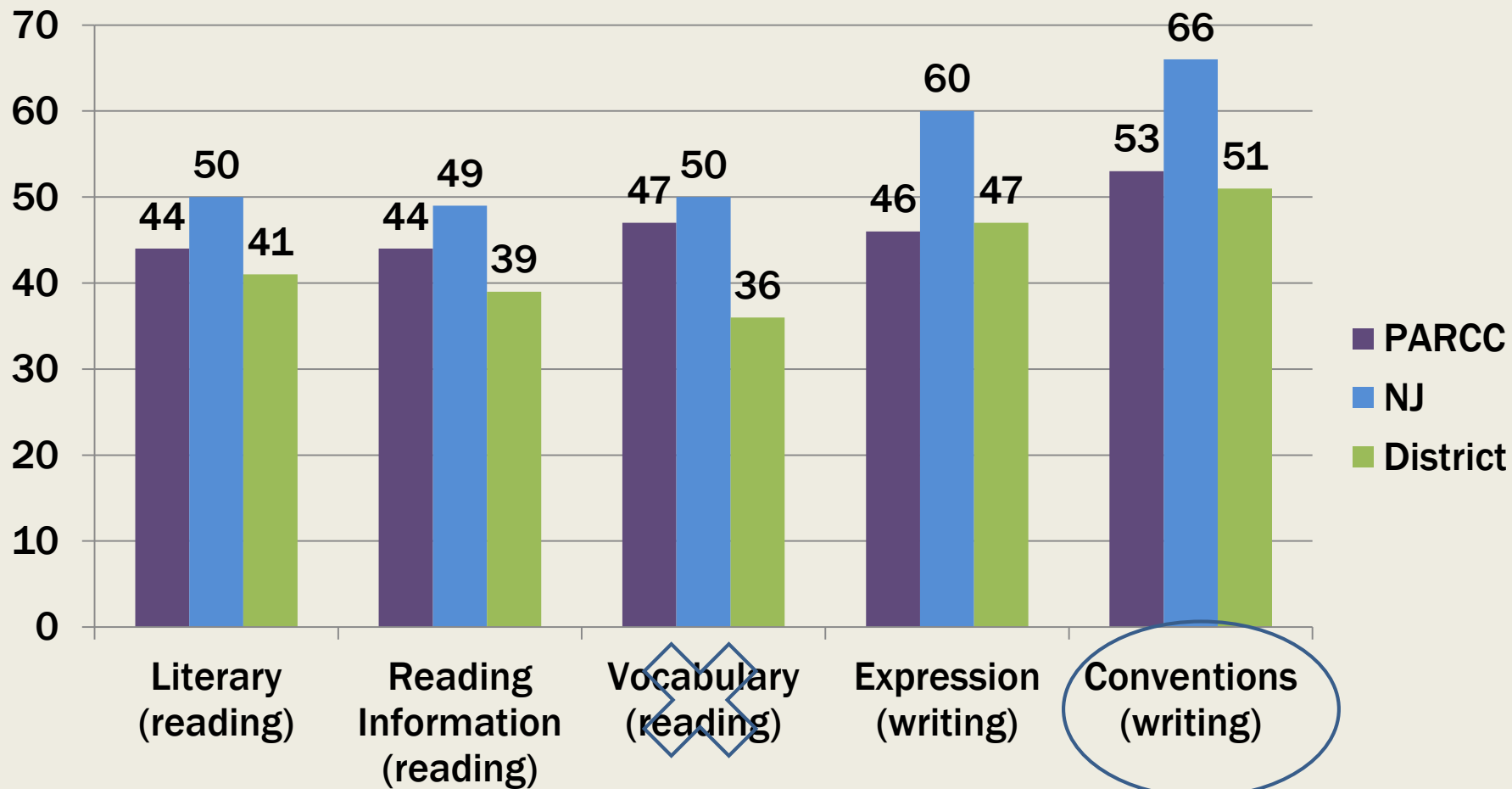

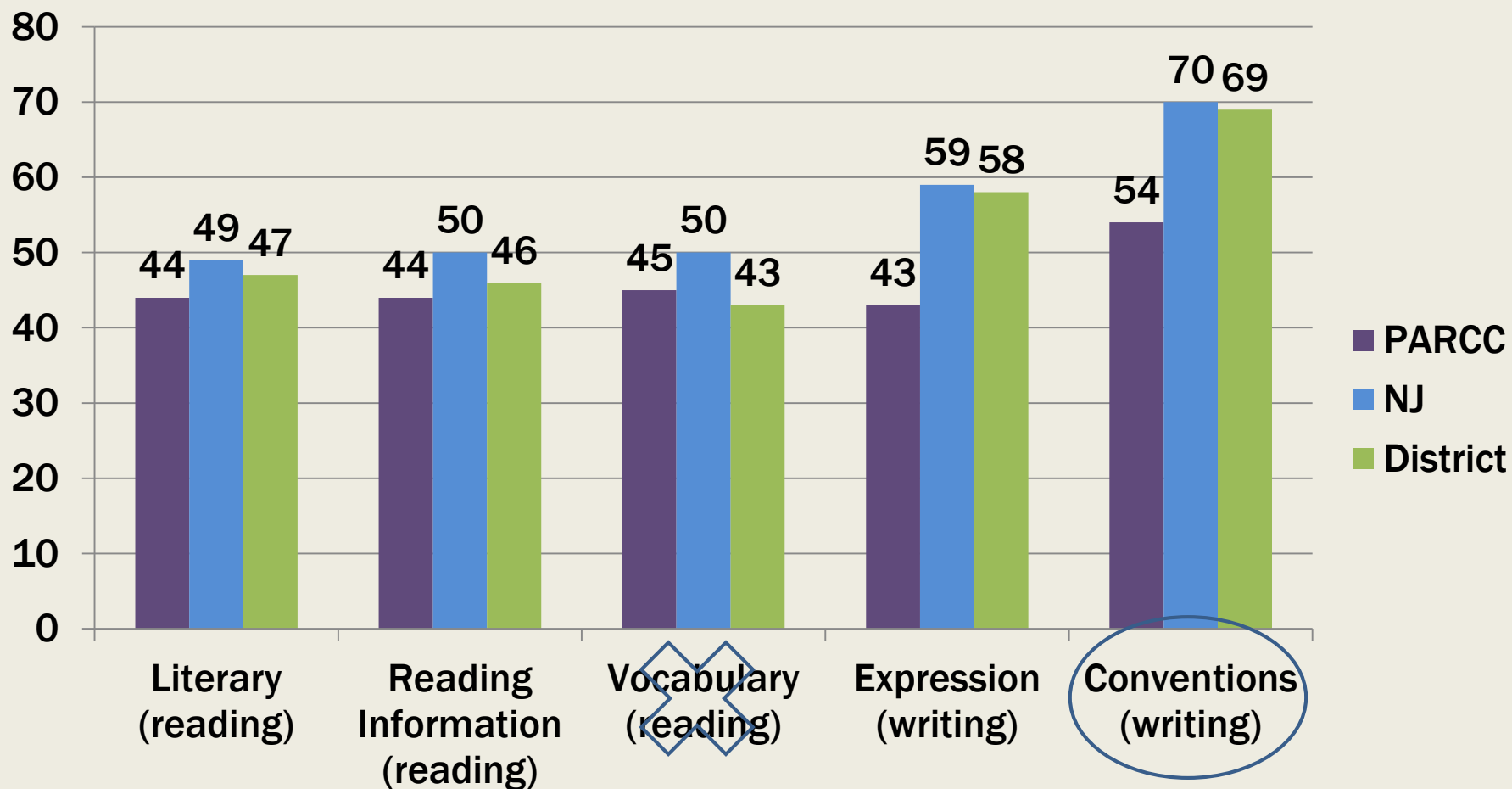

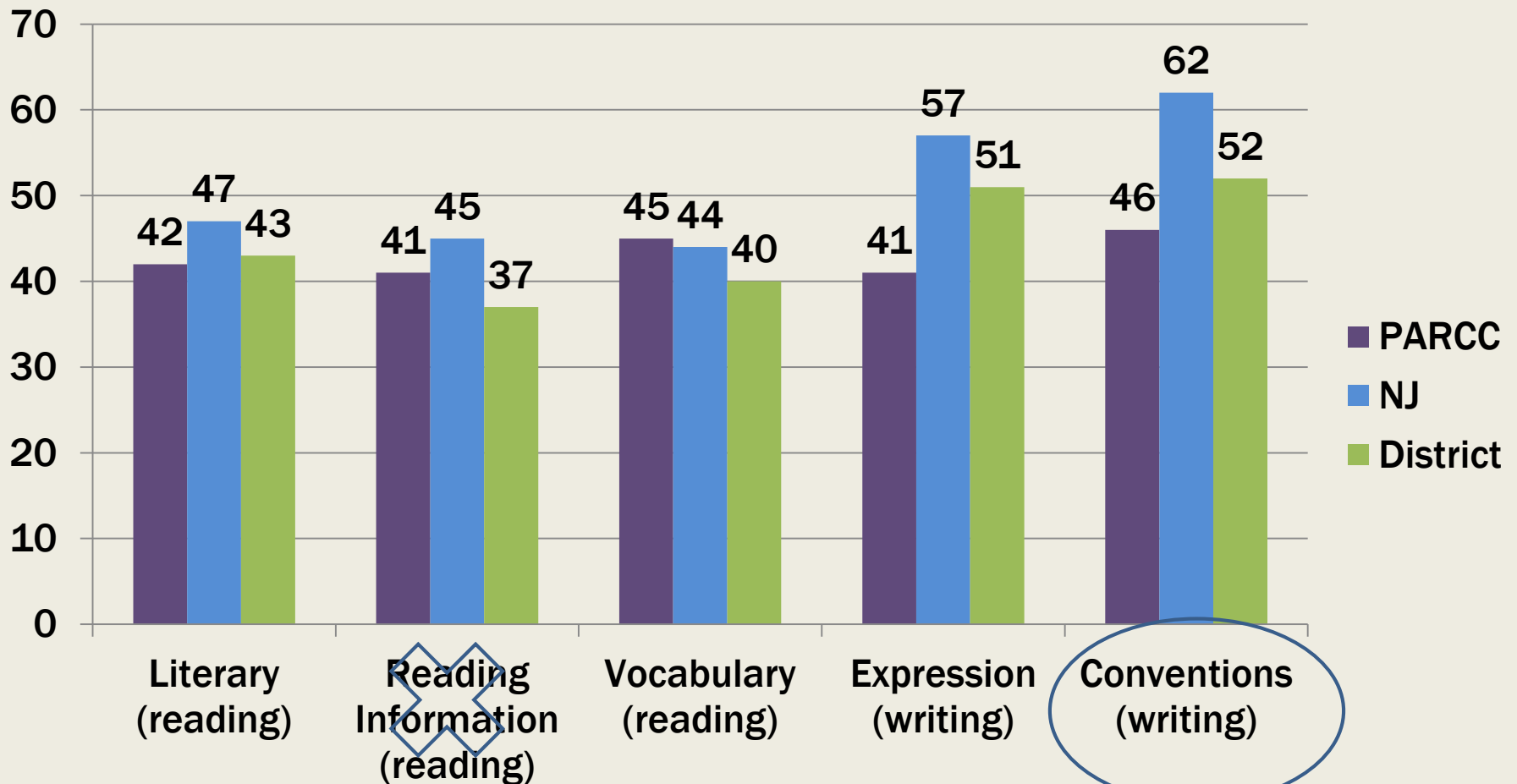

## ELA GRADES 5 "ALL SUBSETS"



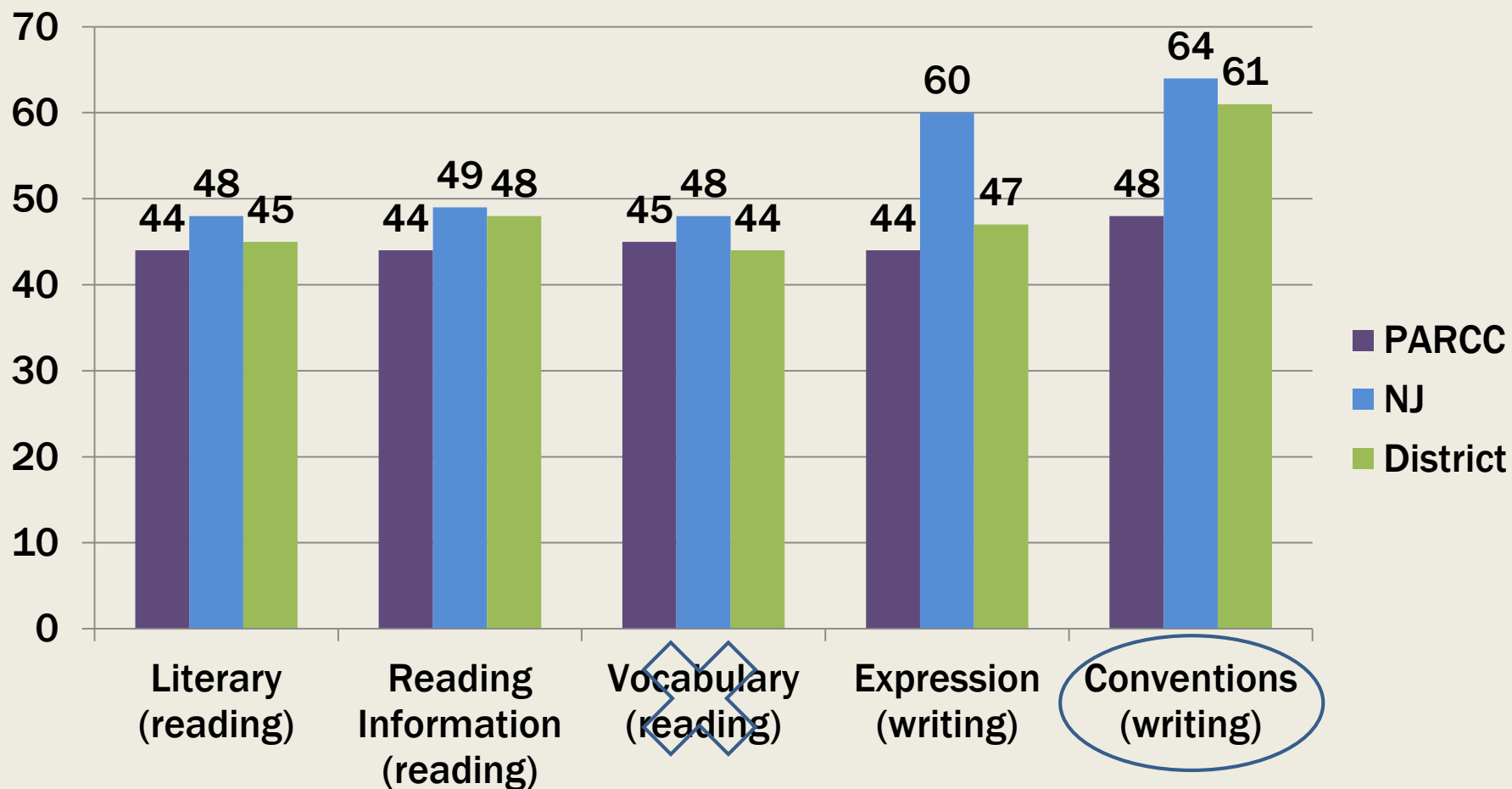

## ELA GRADES 6 "ALL SUBSETS"



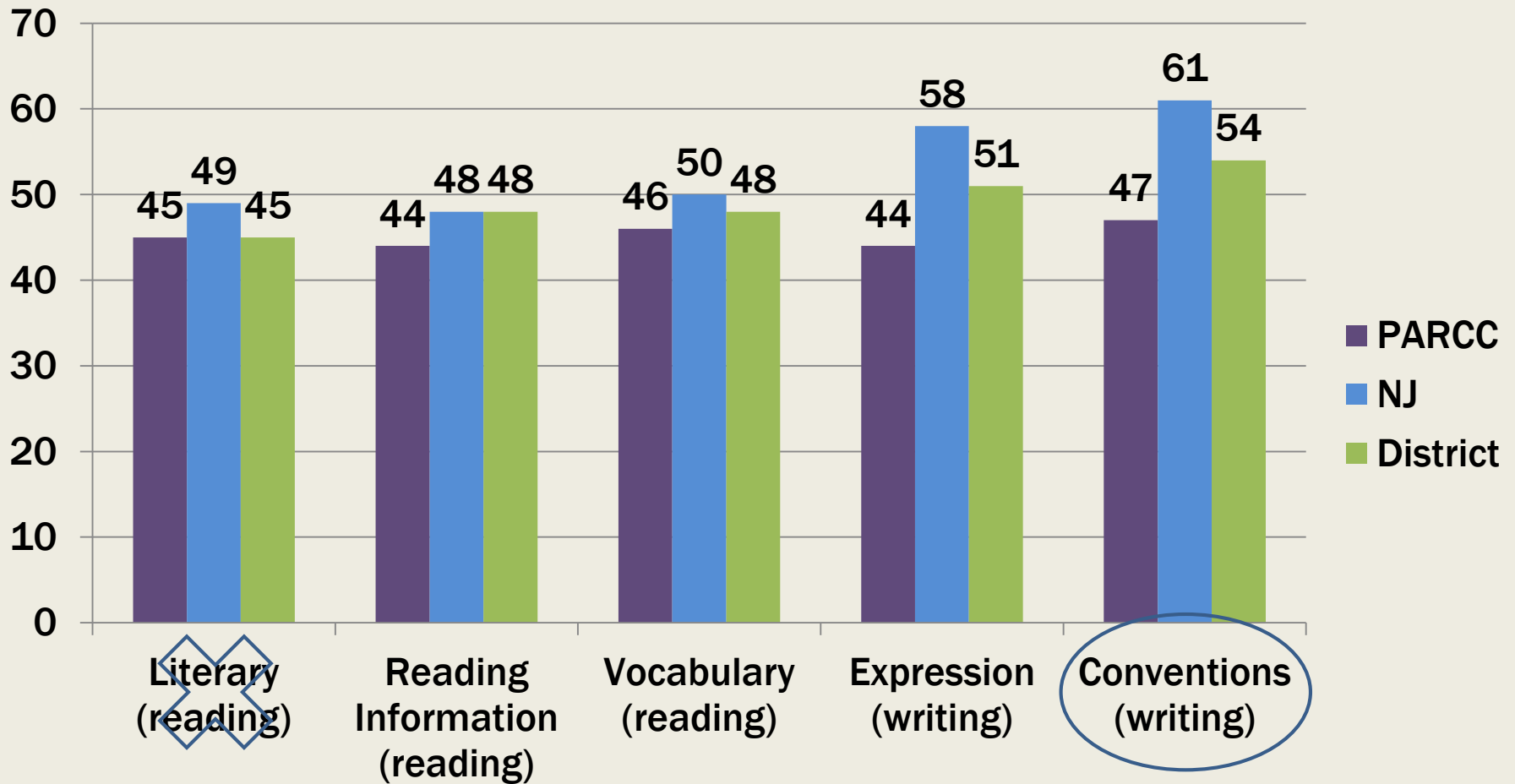

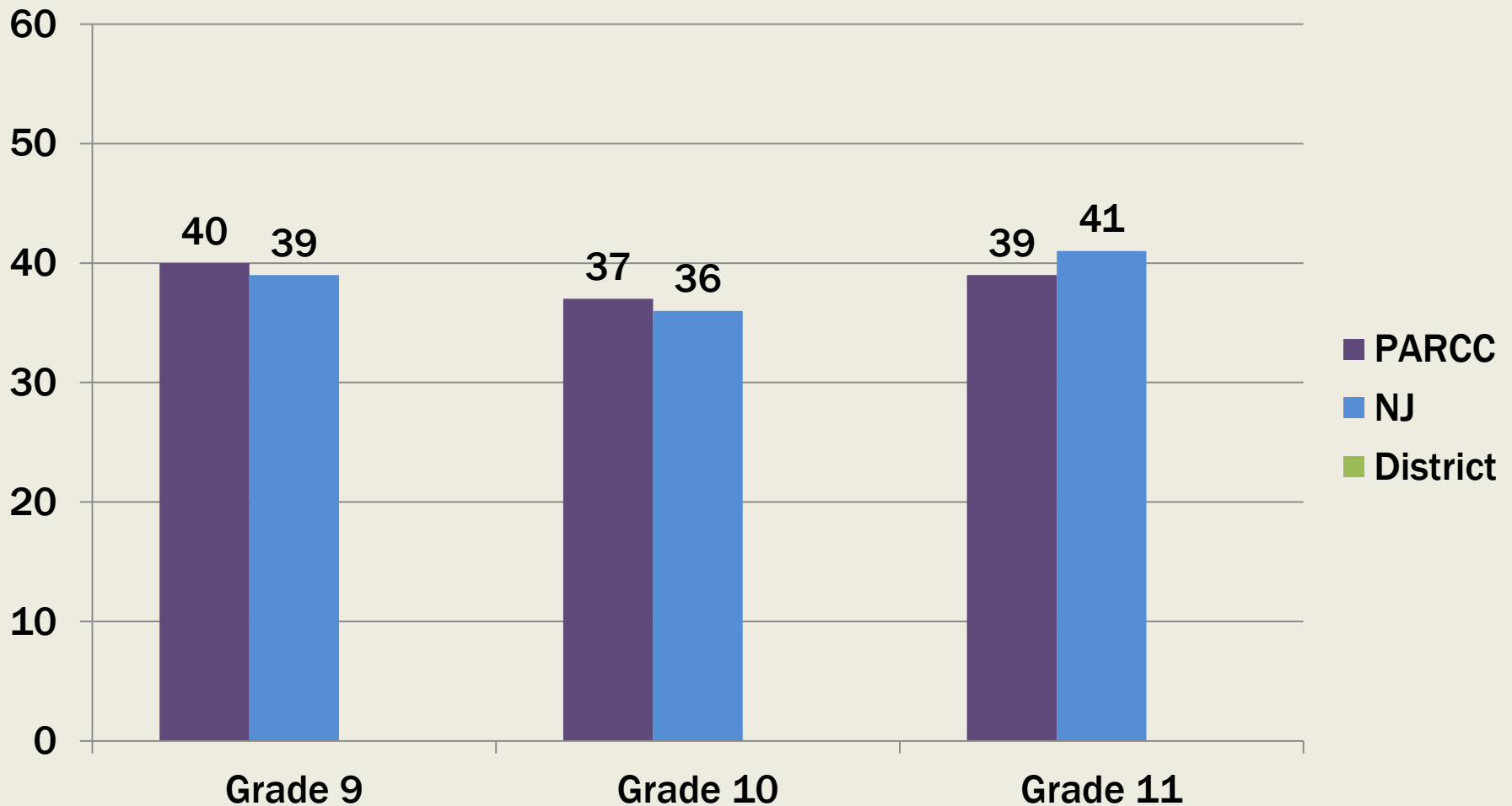
